

1 PILLOWS, PLAYPEN SIDE PADS, PLAYARDS, PORTABLE HOOK-ON CHAIRS, AND
2 STROLLERS; AND

3 (E) ANY ARTICLE MANUFACTURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH A WRITTEN PRESCRIPTION
4 FROM ANY ONE OF THE HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS SET FORTH IN THIS SUBDIVI-
5 SION, OR MANUFACTURED IN ACCORDANCE WITH OTHER COMPARABLE WRITTEN
6 MEDICAL THERAPEUTIC SPECIFICATION, TO BE USED IN CONNECTION WITH THE
7 TREATMENT OR MANAGEMENT OF A NAMED INDIVIDUAL'S PHYSICAL ILLNESS OR
8 INJURY. ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS MAY PROVIDE
9 THE WRITTEN PRESCRIPTION REQUIRED BY THIS SUBDIVISION PROVIDED THAT THE
10 HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL HAS A CURRENT AND VALID LICENSE TO PRACTICE IN
11 NEW YORK OR ANY OTHER STATE OF THE UNITED STATES IN WHICH THE
12 PRESCRIPTION WAS WRITTEN: PHYSICIANS, CHIROPRACTORS OR OSTEOPATHS.

13 2. "RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS ANY ARTICLE OF UPHOLSTERED
14 FURNITURE TO A CONSUMER OR USER OF THE ARTICLE AS PURCHASED.
15 S 37-0903. SMOLDER RESISTANCE STANDARDS.

16 1. BEGINNING JANUARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SIXTEEN, ANY UPHOLSTERED
17 FURNITURE MANUFACTURED FOR SALE IN THE STATE AND SOLD OR OFFERED FOR
18 SALE TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC AT RETAIL OUTLETS IN THE STATE SHALL MEET THE
19 MOST RECENTLY ADOPTED STANDARDS FOR THE SMOLDER RESISTANCE OF MATERIALS
20 USED IN UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE ESTABLISHED BY THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT
21 OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, BUREAU OF ELECTRONIC AND APPLIANCE REPAIR, HOME
22 FURNISHINGS AND THERMAL INSULATION, AND SHALL INCLUDE AN AFFIXED LABEL
23 DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE WITH SUCH STANDARD.

24 2. THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION SHALL NOT APPLY
25 TO:

26 (A) ANY UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE IN A RETAILER'S INVENTORY PRIOR TO JANU-
27 ARY FIRST, TWO THOUSAND SEVENTEEN AND SOLD OR OFFERED FOR SALE AFTER
28 SUCH DATE; OR (B) ANY UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE THAT IS REPAIRED, REUPHOL-
29 STERED, RE-COVERED, RESTORED, RENEWED OR MADE TO ORDER AND SPECIFICATION
30 OF THE USER USING EITHER NEW MATERIALS OR THE OWNER'S MATERIALS.

31 S 2. The commissioner of the New York state division of homeland
32 security and emergency services, in consultation with the New York state
33 office of fire prevention and control, shall on or before February 1,
34 2018, prepare a report to be delivered to the governor and legislature
35 assessing emerging fire barrier materials and other relevant technolo-
36 gies to examine their open flame resistant properties, evaluate their
37 cost effectiveness and determine their applicability in open flame test-
38 ing of upholstered furniture as defined in section 37-0901 of the envi-
39 ronmental conservation law, as added by section one of this act. The
40 commissioner shall consult with interested stakeholders and incorporate
41 findings from similar research performed by the California Bureau of
42 Electronic and Appliance Repair, Home Furnishings and Thermal Insulation
43 (BEARHFTI).

44 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
