AN ACT extending the time within which certain elected officers may file their oaths of office

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, any duly elected county officer or officers within the county of 3 Oswego as of the last county-wide election that failed to take or file their respective oaths of office within the statutorily prescribed period shall continue to serve in such capacity and for the term from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2017 upon the taking and filing of 6 7 oaths of office consistent with section 10 of the public officers law provided such oaths are taken within 30 days from the effective date of Such county officer or officers that take and file their 9 this act. oaths of office within 30 days of the effective date of this act shall 10 11 be deemed to have been continuously serving in office as of January 1, 12 2016.

13 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
