AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to waiving the residency requirement for the code enforcement officer in the village of Aurora, Cayuga county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new subdivision 26 to read as follows:
 - 26. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER GENER-AL LAW, LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR SPECIAL ACT, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUS-TEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, MAY, PROVIDE THAT THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF RESOLUTION, AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, NEED NOT BE A RESIDENT OF SUCH VILLAGE, BUT MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, STATE OF NEW YORK, OR OF A COUNTY WHICH ADJOINS THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA.
- 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new 10 11 subdivision 65 to read as follows:
- 65. IN THE VILLAGE OF AURORA, IN THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, THE PROVISIONS 12 SECTION REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL 13 THIS 14 SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE FOR WHICH HE OR 15 CHOSEN OR WITHIN WHICH HIS OR HER OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS ARE 16 REQUIRED TO BE EXERCISED SHALL NOT PREVENT A PERSON FROM HOLDING OFFICE OF CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON RESIDES IN 17 OF CAYUGA OR AN ADJOINING COUNTY WITHIN THE STATE OF NEW 18 THE COUNTY THEFUNCTIONS
- YORK. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE PERSON PERFORMING 19
- 20 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN ANY OTHER VILLAGE SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF SUCH
- 21 VILLAGE, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 22 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
