AN ACT to authorize the city of New York to acquire, by eminent domain, a certain parcel of real property in the borough of Brooklyn

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of article two of the eminent domain procedure law, the city of New York, acting by and through its legislative body, is authorized, without consideration of other sites for a public project and any other requirement of such article, to acquire by eminent domain the real property in the borough of Brooklyn at 211 Ainslie Street, otherwise known on the tax map of the city of New York as block 2770, lot 1, for the purpose of a public project.
