AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to authorizing the state liquor authority to impose a one year moratorium on the issuance of new licenses to sell liquor on premises in certain instances

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 118 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 To limit in its discretion the number of licenses of each class to 5 be issued within the state or any political subdivision thereof, and in connection therewith to prohibit the acceptance of applications for such class or classes of licenses which have been so limited. PROVIDED, 7 8 HOWEVER, IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, (A) 9 (I) A REOUEST FROM THE STATE SENATOR OR STATE SENATORS AND ASSEMBLY MEMBER OR ASSEMBLY MEMBERS AND NEW YORK CITY COUNCIL MEMBER OR 10 YORK CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE RESIDENTS OF A NEIGHBOR-11 12 HOOD WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE AND (II) A RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A COMMUNITY BOARD OR BOARDS OR OTHER LOCAL BODY OR 13 14 BODIES WHOSE JURISDICTION COVERS SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD REQUESTING A MORATO-SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSES TO SELL 15 WITHIN LIOUOR AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ISSUED 16 PURSUANT 17 SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B, SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER AND (B) A FINDING BY THE AUTHORITY THAT THE 18 19 NUMBER OF SUCH LICENSES ISSUED WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD PURSUANT TO 20 SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B, SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER HAS DOUBLED OVER A THREE YEAR 21 PERIOD, THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH A ONE YEAR MORATORIUM WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD 22 23 ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSES TO SELL LIQUOR AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION 24 PREMISES ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, 25 SIXTY-FOUR-B, SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER AND

EXPLANATION--Matter in ITALICS (underscored) is new; matter in brackets [ ] is old law to be omitted.

ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SUCH LICENSES. NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS

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SUBDIVISION SHALL PREVENT THE TRANSFER OF ANY LICENSE AT THE SAME PREM-ISES UNDER THIS CHAPTER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "NEIGHBOR-HOOD" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE RESIDENTS THEREOF AS INCLUDING A UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS.

- S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 83 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 2. To limit in its discretion the number of licenses of each class to 10 issued within the state or any political subdivision thereof, and in connection therewith to prohibit the acceptance of applications for such 11 12 class or classes of licenses which have been so limited. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE, (A) UPON 13 14 RECEIPT OF (I) A REQUEST FROM THE STATE SENATOR OR STATE SENATORS 15 ASSEMBLY MEMBER OR ASSEMBLY MEMBERS AND NEW YORK CITY COUNCIL MEMBER OR 16 NEW YORK CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS REPRESENTING THE RESIDENTS OF A NEIGHBOR-17 HOOD WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE MILLION OR MORE AND (II) A 18 RESOLUTION ADOPTED BY A COMMUNITY BOARD OR BOARDS OR OTHER LOCAL BODY OR 19 WHOSE JURISDICTION COVERS SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD REQUESTING A MORATO-20 RIUM WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSES TO 21 LIOUOR AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES ISSUED PURSUANT TO 22 SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B, SIXTY-FOUR-C SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER AND (B) A FINDING BY THE AUTHORITY THAT THE 23 24 NUMBER OF SUCH LICENSES ISSUED WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD PURSUANT TO 25 SIXTY-FOUR, SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B, SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR-C 26 SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER HAS DOUBLED OVER A THREE YEAR PERIOD, THE 27 AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH A ONE YEAR MORATORIUM WITHIN SUCH NEIGHBORHOOD ON THE ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSES TO SELL LIQUOR AT RETAIL FOR CONSUMPTION 28 ON THE PREMISES ISSUED PURSUANT TO SECTIONS SIXTY-FOUR, 29 SIXTY-FOUR-A, SIXTY-FOUR-B, SIXTY-FOUR-C AND SIXTY-FOUR-D OF THIS CHAPTER AND THE 30 ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR SUCH LICENSES. NOTHING CONTAINED IN THIS 31 32 SUBDIVISION SHALL PREVENT THE TRANSFER OF ANY LICENSE AT THE SAME PREM-UNDER THIS CHAPTER. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SUBDIVISION, "NEIGHBOR-33 HOOD" MEANS A GEOGRAPHIC AREA WITHIN A CITY HAVING A POPULATION OF 34 MILLION OR MORE THAT IS RECOGNIZED BY THE RESIDENTS THEREOF AS INCLUDING 35 A UNIQUE COMMUNITY OF INTERESTS. 36

This act shall take effect immediately, provided that the amend-38 ments to subdivision 2 of section 17 of the alcoholic beverage control 39 law made by section one of this act shall be subject to the expiration 40 and reversion of such subdivision pursuant to section 4 of chapter 118 41 of the laws of 2012, as amended, when upon such date the provisions of 42 section two of this act shall take effect.
