WHEREAS, Beginning as an Administrative Assistant, Irene V. Scheid climbed the ranks of APEC to become Office Manager, Assistant Executive Director, and then Interim Executive Director; in 1991, she accepted the task of Executive Director, the esteemed position from which she will retire; and

WHEREAS, Under the able leadership of Irene V. Scheid, APEC's budget has shown remarkable financial growth and the organization is anticipating their new Silver LEED environmental center within the next couple of years; and

WHEREAS, It is the sense of this Legislative Body that those who enhance the quality of life in their community and have shown a long and sustained commitment to the maintenance of high standards in their profession, certainly have earned the recognition and applause of all the citizens of this great Empire State; now, therefore, be it
