AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to authorizing a dormitory facility for the legislature; to amend the legislative law, in relation to per diems of legislative members; and making an appropriation therefor

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1680-s to read as follows:

3 S 1680-S. LEGISLATIVE DORMITORY FACILITY. 1. THE AUTHORITY IS AUTHOR-4 IZED INTO AGREEMENTS RELATING TO, AMONG OTHER THINGS, THE TO ENTER 5 ACOUISITION OF PROPERTY OR INTERESTS THEREIN, THE CONSTRUCTION, RECON-6 STRUCTION, REHABILITATION, IMPROVEMENT, EQUIPPING AND FURNISHING OF A DORMITORY FACILITY IN ALBANY, NEW YORK FOR USE BY MEMBERS OF THE LEGIS-7 8 LATURE WHEN IN PERFORMANCE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

9 2. THE AUTHORITY SHALL OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE DORMITORY FACILITY 10 APPROVED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.

11 S 2. Subdivision 2 of section 5 of the legislative law, as amended by 12 section 1 of part M-1 of chapter 407 of the laws of 1999, is amended to 13 read as follows:

14 2. Each member of the legislature shall receive [payment of actual and 15 necessary transportation expenses and] a per diem equivalent to the most recent federal per diem rates published by the General Services Adminis-16 tration and set forth in 41 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) Part 17 301, A, while in travel status in the performance of his or her duties; 18 App. 19 and such other reasonable expenses as may be necessary for the perform-20 ance of the member's responsibilities as determined by the temporary president of the senate or speaker of the assembly for their respective 21 houses. The per diem allowances, including partial per diem allowances, 22

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shall be made pursuant to regulations promulgated by the temporary president of the senate and the speaker of the assembly for their respective houses, on audit and warrant of the comptroller on vouchers approved by the temporary president of the senate or his or her designee and the speaker of the assembly or his or her designee for their respective houses.

7 3. The sum of nine million dollars (\$9,000,000), or so much thereof S 8 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the dormitory authority 9 out of any moneys in the state treasury in the general fund to the cred-10 of the state purposes account, not otherwise appropriated, and made it immediately available, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of 11 this act. Such moneys shall be payable on the audit and warrant of the 12 13 comptroller on vouchers certified or approved by the dormitory authori-14 ty.

15 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that section two of this act shall take effect upon the date of occupancy of 16 17 the legislative dormitory facility by members of the legislature; provided, further, that the dormitory authority shall notify the legis-18 19 lative bill drafting commission upon the occurrence of the enactment of the legislation provided for in sections one and two of this act in 20 21 order that the commission may maintain an accurate and timely effective 22 data base of the official text of the laws of the state of New York in furtherance of effectuating the provisions of section 44 of the legisla-23 tive law and section 70-b of the public officers law. 24
