AN ACT to amend the agriculture and markets law, in relation to labeling requirements for fish wholesalers

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The agriculture and markets law is amended by adding a new 2 section 214-o to read as follows:
 - S 214-O. LABELING REQUIREMENTS FOR FISH WHOLESALERS. ANY WHOLESALER OF FISH AND/OR SEAFOOD MAY ONLY SELL SUCH FISH OR SEAFOOD THAT IS EDIBLE OR OTHERWISE SALEABLE FOR CONSUMPTION PURPOSES, IN SEALED, CLEARLY LABELED CONTAINERS. THE LABELS MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: 1. THE IDENTITY OF THE COMMODITY, 2. THE WEIGHT OF THE COMMODITY, 3. THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE SHIPPER, PACKER, OR DISTRIBUTOR, 4. THE STATE AND COUNTY OF COMMODITY ORIGIN, AND 5. DATE OF HARVEST.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
