AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the crime of domestic abuse; and to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to a judicial diversion program for domestic abuse defendants

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding three new sections 2 120.80, 120.83 and 120.85 to read as follows:

3 S 120.80 DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE THIRD DEGREE.

4 A PERSON IS GUILTY OF DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE THIRD DEGREE WHEN, WITH 5 INTENT TO HARASS, ANNOY, OR ALARM HIS OR HER SPOUSE, FORMER SPOUSE, 6 FELLOW PARENT OF A CHILD IN COMMON, OR DOMESTIC PARTNER, HE OR SHE 7 STRIKES, SHOVES, KICKS, OR OTHERWISE SUBJECTS SUCH PERSON TO PHYSICAL 8 CONTACT OR ATTEMPTS OR THREATENS TO DO THE SAME.

9 FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, "SPOUSE" SHALL MEAN PERSONS LEGALLY MARRIED TO ONE ANOTHER, "FORMER SPOUSE" SHALL MEAN PERSONS 10 FORMERLY MARRIED TO ONE ANOTHER REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THEY STILL RESIDE IN THE 11 SAME HOUSEHOLD, "FELLOW PARENT OF A CHILD IN COMMON" SHALL MEAN 12 PERSONS 13 WHO HAVE A CHILD IN COMMON REGARDLESS OF WHETHER SUCH PERSONS HAVE BEEN 14 MARRIED OR HAVE LIVED TOGETHER, AND "DOMESTIC PARTNER " SHALL MEAN PERSONS WHO ARE LIVING OR HAVE LIVED TOGETHER FOR AN EXTENDED DURATION 15 16 IN AN INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP MARKED BY SEXUAL, PHYSICAL, OR FINANCIAL 17 INTERDEPENDENCE.

18 DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE THIRD DEGREE IS A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR.

19 S 120.83 DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE SECOND DEGREE.

A PERSON IS GUILTY OF DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE SECOND DEGREE WHEN WITH INTENT TO HARASS, ANNOY, OR ALARM HIS OR HER SPOUSE, FORMER SPOUSE, FELLOW PARENT OF A CHILD IN COMMON, OR DOMESTIC PARTNER, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 120.80 OF THIS ARTICLE, HE OR SHE CAUSES SUCH PERSON PHYSICAL INJURY.

13	DOMESTIC PARTNER, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 120.80 OF THIS ARTICLE, BY MEANS
14	OF A DEADLY WEAPON OR A DANGEROUS INSTRUMENT; OR
15	2. HE OR SHE COMMITS THE CRIME OF DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE SECOND DEGREE
16	AND HAS PREVIOUSLY BEEN CONVICTED OF THE CRIME OF DOMESTIC ABUSE IN ANY
17	DEGREE AS DEFINED IN THIS ARTICLE WITHIN THE PRECEDING FIVE YEARS.
18	DOMESTIC ABUSE IN THE FIRST DEGREE IS A CLASS E FELONY.
19	S 2. The criminal procedure law is amended by adding a new article 217
20	to read as follows:

22	JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM FOR DOMESTIC ABUSE DEFENDANTS
23	SECTION 217.00 DEFINITIONS.
24	217.05 JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM; COURT PROCEDURES.
25 26	S 217.00 DEFINITIONS. THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS ARE APPLICABLE TO THIS ARTICLE:
20 27	1. "ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT" SHALL MEAN ANY PERSON WHO STANDS CHARGED WITH
28	DOMESTIC ABUSE AS DEFINED IN SECTIONS 120.80, 120.83 AND 120.85 OF THE
29	PENAL LAW, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, A DEFENDANT IS NOT AN "ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT"
30	IF HE OR SHE:
31	(A) WITHIN THE PRECEDING TEN YEARS, EXCLUDING ANY TIME DURING WHICH
32	THE OFFENDER WAS INCARCERATED FOR ANY REASON BETWEEN THE TIME OF COMMIS-
33	SION OF THE PREVIOUS OFFENSE AND THE TIME OF COMMISSION OF THE PRESENT

47	1. AT ANY TIME AFTER THE ARRAIGNMENT OF AN ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT, BUT
48	PRIOR TO THE ENTRY OF A PLEA OF GUILTY OR THE COMMENCEMENT OF TRIAL, THE
49	COURT MAY DETERMINE THAT AN ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT SHOULD BE OFFERED JUDI-
50	CIAL DIVERSION IN A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM. AN ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT MAY
51	DECLINE TO PARTICIPATE IN SUCH A PROGRAM AT ANY TIME. PRIOR TO THE

	(A) THE PEOPLE AND THE COURT CONSENT TO THE ENTRY OF SUCH AN ORDER WITHOUT A PLEA OF GUILTY; OR

1 (B) BASED ON A FINDING OF EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES, THE COURT DETER-2 MINES THAT A PLEA OF GUILTY SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED. FOR PURPOSES OF THIS 3 SUBDIVISION, EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST WHEN, REGARDLESS OF THE 4 ULTIMATE DISPOSITION OF THE CASE, THE ENTRY OF A PLEA OF GUILTY IS LIKE-5 LY TO RESULT IN SEVERE COLLATERAL CONSEQUENCES.

6 2. THE ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT SHALL AGREE ON THE RECORD OR IN WRITING TO 7 ABIDE BY THE RELEASE CONDITIONS SET BY THE COURT, WHICH, SHALL INCLUDE: 8 PARTICIPATION IN A SPECIFIED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM; PERIODIC COURT 9 APPEARANCES; AND A REQUIREMENT THAT THE DEFENDANT REFRAIN FROM ENGAGING 10 IN CRIMINAL BEHAVIORS.

11 3. UPON AN ELIGIBLE DEFENDANT'S AGREEMENT TO ABIDE BY THE CONDITIONS SET BY THE COURT, THE COURT SHALL ISSUE A SECURING ORDER PROVIDING FOR 12 BAIL OR RELEASE ON THE DEFENDANT'S OWN RECOGNIZANCE AND CONDITIONING ANY 13 14 RELEASE UPON THE AGREED UPON CONDITIONS. THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM SHALL BEGIN AS SPECIFIED BY THE COURT AND AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER 15 16 THE DEFENDANT'S RELEASE. IN THE EVENT THAT A DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM 17 IS NOT IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE OR BECOMES UNAVAILABLE DURING THE COURSE OF THE DEFENDANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM, THE 18 19 COURT MAY RELEASE THE DEFENDANT PURSUANT TO THE SECURING ORDER.

4. DURING THE PERIOD OF A DEFENDANT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM, THE COURT SHALL RETAIN JURISDICTION OF THE DEFENDANT. 20 21 THE COURT MAY REQUIRE THE DEFENDANT TO APPEAR IN COURT AT ANY 22 TIME ΤO ENABLE THE COURT TO MONITOR THE DEFENDANT'S PROGRESS IN THE PROGRAM. THE 23 COURT SHALL PROVIDE NOTICE, REASONABLE UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES, TO THE 24 25 PEOPLE, THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM PROVIDER, THE DEFENDANT AND THE DEFENDANT'S COUNSEL WHENEVER IT ORDERS OR OTHERWISE REQUIRES THE APPEAR-26 27 ANCE OF THE DEFENDANT IN COURT. FAILURE TO APPEAR AS REQUIRED WITHOUT REASONABLE CAUSE THEREFOR SHALL CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF THE CONDITIONS 28 29 OF THE COURT'S AGREEMENT WITH THE DEFENDANT.

5. UPON THE COURT'S DETERMINATION THAT THE DEFENDANT HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROGRAM AND HAS OTHERWISE SATISFIED THE CONDITIONS REQUIRED FOR SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM, THE COURT SHALL COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS IT SET FOR FINAL DISPOSITION WHEN IT ACCEPTED THE DEFENDANT'S AGREEMENT TO PARTIC-IPATE IN THE JUDICIAL DIVERSION PROGRAM. SUCH DISPOSITION MAY INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO:

(A) REQUIRING THE DEFENDANT TO UNDERGO A PERIOD OF INTERIM PROBATION
SUPERVISION AND, UPON THE DEFENDANT'S SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE
INTERIM PROBATION SUPERVISION TERM, NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISION OF ANY
OTHER LAW, PERMITTING THE DEFENDANT TO WITHDRAW HIS OR HER GUILTY PLEA
AND DISMISSING THE INDICTMENT; OR

(B) REQUIRING THE DEFENDANT TO UNDERGO A PERIOD OF INTERIM PROBATION 42 43 SUPERVISION AND, UPON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE INTERIM PROBATION SUPERVISION TERM, 44 NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISION OF ANY OTHER LAW, 45 PERMITTING THE DEFENDANT TO WITHDRAW HIS OR HER GUILTY PLEA, ENTER A GUILTY PLEA TO A MISDEMEANOR OFFENSE AND SENTENCING THE DEFENDANT AS 46 47 IN THE PLEA AGREEMENT, WHICH MAY INCLUDE A PERIOD OF PROBATION PROMISED 48 SUPERVISION PURSUANT TO SECTION 65.00 OF THE PENAL LAW; OR

49 (C) ALLOWING THE DEFENDANT TO WITHDRAW HIS OR HER GUILTY PLEA AND 50 DISMISSING THE INDICTMENT.

51 S 3. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 52 have become a law.
