AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to requiring hepatitis C virus testing of newborns

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2 2500-1 to read as follows:
  - S 2500-L. HEPATITIS C VIRUS (HCV); TESTING OF NEWBORNS. 1. IN ORDER TO IMPROVE THE HEALTH OUTCOMES OF NEWBORNS, AND TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO CARE AND TREATMENT FOR NEWBORNS INFECTED WITH OR EXPOSED TO HEPATITIS C VIRUS (HCV) AND THEIR MOTHERS, THE COMMISSIONER SHALL ESTABLISH A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM FOR THE TESTING OF NEWBORNS FOR THE PRESENCE OF HEPATITIS C VIRUS (HCV) AND/OR THE PRESENCE OF ANTIBODIES TO SUCH VIRUS.
- 9 2. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROMULGATE REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE IMPLE-10 MENTATION OF THE PROGRAM REQUIRED PURSUANT TO SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS 11 SECTION, INCLUDING THE ADMINISTRATION OF TESTING, COUNSELING, TRACKING,
- 12 DISCLOSURE OF TEST RESULTS PURSUANT TO SECTION TWENTY-SEVEN HUNDRED
- 13 EIGHTY-TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, FOLLOW-UP REVIEWS, AND EDUCATIONAL ACTIV-
- 14 ITIES RELATING TO SUCH TESTING.
