AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to authorizing the leasing of land adjacent to state and local highways for the purpose of the construction and operation of solar and wind electric generating systems; and to amend the public authorities law, in relation to granting such authorization to the metropolitan transportation authority

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 10 of the highway law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 38-a to read as follows:

38-A. HAVE THE POWER TO LEASE, FOR A TERM NOT 3 TO EXCEED NINETY-NINE 4 PROPERTY RIGHTS IN AIR SPACE, AND/OR UNUSED SURFACE OR YEARS, THE5 SUBSURFACE SPACE IN CONNECTION WITH ANY STATE-OWNED PROPERTY UNDER HIS 6 HER JURISDICTION OR OTHER PROPERTY ACQUIRED FOR STATE HIGHWAY OR 7 PURPOSES. SUCH LEASES SHALL BE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND 8 OPERATION OF SOLAR AND/OR WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEMS. SUCH SYSTEMS MOUNTED UPON SOUND BARRIERS, RETAINING WALLS, OPEN UNOBSTRUCTED 9 MAY ΒE 10 AREAS, PARKING LOTS, BRIDGES, BRIDGE STRUCTURES, SIGNS, SIGN STRUCTURES AND UPON ANY OTHER AREA UPON THE LEASED REAL PROPERTY. THE CONSTRUCTION 11 AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEMS SUBJECT TO A 12 13 LEASE AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO STATE AND RULES AND REGULATIONS, BUT SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY 14 FEDERAL LAW, LOCAL LAW, RESOLUTION, ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION. THE TERMS 15 OF ANY SUCH LEASE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSIONER AND SHALL BE SUBJECT 16 TO THE APPROVAL OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL. IN ORDER 17 ΤO CARRY ANY SUCH INTO EFFECT, THE COMMISSIONER IS HEREBY AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AND 18 LEASE 19 DELIVER, IN THE NAME OF THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE, A LEASE TO SUCH PROPER-TY RIGHTS. EACH SUCH INSTRUMENT OF LEASE SHALL BE PREPARED BY THE ATTOR-20 21 NEY GENERAL. NO SUCH LEASE BY THE COMMISSIONER SHALL DEPRIVE AN ABUTTING LANDOWNER OF HIS OR HER RIGHT OF ACCESS. 22

23 S 2. Section 102 of the highway law is amended by adding a new subdi-24 vision 19 to read as follows:

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19. HAVE THE POWER, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY GOVERNING 1 2 BODY, TO LEASE, FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED NINETY-NINE YEARS, THE PROPERTY 3 RIGHTS IN AIR SPACE, AND/OR UNUSED SURFACE OR SUBSURFACE SPACE IN 4 CONNECTION WITH ANY COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY UNDER HIS OR HER JURISDICTION 5 OR OTHER PROPERTY ACQUIRED FOR COUNTY ROAD PURPOSES. SUCH LEASES SHALL 6 BE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND/OR 7 WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEMS. SUCH SYSTEMS MAY BE MOUNTED UPON SOUND 8 BARRIERS, RETAINING WALLS, OPEN UNOBSTRUCTED AREAS, PARKING LOTS, BRIDG-ES, BRIDGE STRUCTURES, SIGNS, SIGN STRUCTURES AND UPON ANY OTHER AREA 9 10 UPON THE LEASED REAL PROPERTY. THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEMS SUBJECT TO A LEASE AUTHORIZED BY 11 THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO STATE AND FEDERAL LAW, RULES AND 12 REGULATIONS, BUT SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY LOCAL LAW, RESOLUTION, ORDINANCE, RULE OR REGULATION. THE TERMS OF ANY SUCH LEASE SHALL BE 13 14 DETERMINED BY THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT, AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE 15 16 APPROVAL OF THE COUNTY GOVERNING BODY. SUCH LEASE BY THE COUNTY SUPER-INTENDENT SHALL NOT DEPRIVE AN ABUTTING LANDOWNER OF HIS OR HER RIGHT OF 17 18 ACCESS.

19 S 3. Section 140 of the highway law is amended by adding a new subdi-20 vision 20 to read as follows:

21 20. HAVE THE POWER, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE TOWN BOARD, TO LEASE, FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED NINETY-NINE YEARS, THE PROPERTY RIGHTS 22 23 IN AIR SPACE, AND/OR UNUSED SURFACE OR SUBSURFACE SPACE IN CONNECTION WITH ANY TOWN-OWNED PROPERTY UNDER HIS OR HER JURISDICTION OR OTHER 24 25 PROPERTY ACQUIRED FOR TOWN ROAD PURPOSES. SUCH LEASES SHALL BE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND/OR WIND ELECTRIC 26 GENERATING SYSTEMS. SUCH SYSTEMS MAY BE MOUNTED UPON SOUND BARRIERS, 27 RETAINING WALLS, OPEN UNOBSTRUCTED AREAS, PARKING LOTS, BRIDGES, BRIDGE 28 STRUCTURES, SIGNS, SIGN STRUCTURES AND UPON ANY OTHER AREA UPON THE 29 LEASED REAL PROPERTY. THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND WIND 30 ELECTRIC GENERATING SYSTEMS SUBJECT TO A LEASE AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBDI-31 32 VISION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO STATE AND FEDERAL LAW, RULES AND REGULATIONS BUT SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY LOCAL LAW, RESOLUTION, ORDINANCE, RULE 33 OR REGULATION. THE TERMS OF ANY SUCH LEASE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE 34 35 TOWN SUPERINTENDENT, AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE TOWN BOARD. SUCH LEASE BY THE TOWN SUPERINTENDENT SHALL NOT DEPRIVE AN ABUT-36 37 TING LANDOWNER OF HIS OR HER RIGHT OF ACCESS.

38 S 4. Section 1265 of the public authorities law is amended by adding a 39 new subdivision 15 to read as follows:

40 15. TO LEASE, FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED NINETY-NINE YEARS, THE PROPERTY RIGHTS IN AIR SPACE, AND/OR UNUSED SURFACE OR SUBSURFACE SPACE IN 41 CONNECTION WITH ANY AUTHORITY OWNED PROPERTY OR OTHER PROPERTY ACQUIRED 42 43 FOR AUTHORITY PURPOSES. SUCH LEASES SHALL BE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE 44 CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND/OR WIND ELECTRIC GENERATING 45 SYSTEMS. SUCH SYSTEMS MAY BE MOUNTED UPON SOUND BARRIERS, RETAINING WALLS, OPEN UNOBSTRUCTED AREAS, PARKING LOTS, BRIDGES, BRIDGE STRUC-46 TURES, SIGNS, SIGN STRUCTURES AND UPON ANY OTHER AREA UPON THE LEASED 47 REAL PROPERTY. THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF SOLAR AND WIND ELECTRIC 48 GENERATING SYSTEMS SUBJECT TO A LEASE AUTHORIZED BY THIS SUBDIVISION 49 50 SHALL BE SUBJECT TO STATE AND FEDERAL LAW, RULES AND REGULATIONS, BUT SHALL NOT BE SUBJECT TO ANY LOCAL LAW, RESOLUTION, ORDINANCE, RULE OR 51 REGULATION. THE TERMS OF ANY SUCH LEASE SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE 52 AUTHORITY. SUCH LEASE BY THE AUTHORITY SHALL NOT DEPRIVE AN ABUTTING 53 54 LANDOWNER OF HIS OR HER RIGHT OF ACCESS.

55 S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
