AN ACT to amend the transportation law, in relation to requiring safety reports to potential customers of contract carriers of passengers by motor vehicle

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 10 of section 140 of the transportation law is 2 renumbered subdivision 11 and a new subdivision 10 is added to read as 3 follows:
- 4 10. NO CONTRACT CARRIER OF PASSENGERS BY MOTOR VEHICLE, AS DEFINED BY 5 SUBDIVISION NINE OF SECTION TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, SHALL ENTER INTO A 6 CONTRACT TO PROVIDE SERVICES FOR ANY CUSTOMER WITHOUT FIRST PROVIDING 7 THAT CUSTOMER WITH:
- 8 A. A COPY, IN WRITING, OF THE CONTRACT CARRIER'S THREE MOST RECENT 9 FEDERAL SAFETY STATUS MEASUREMENT SYSTEM (SAFESTAT) SCORES; AND
- 10 B. AN EXPLANATION OF HOW THE SCORE IS CALCULATED AND WHAT THE SCORE 11 MEANS.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
