AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the registration of snowmobiles used solely for the purpose of hunting, fishing or trapping

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 2222 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 2-A. THE COMMISSIONER IS AUTHORIZED TO REGISTER A SNOWMOBILE NON-TRAIL SNOWMOBILE WHICH SHALL BE USED SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF GAIN-5 ING ACCESS TO HUNTING, FISHING AND TRAPPING AREAS. SUCH REGISTRATION SHALL BE COMPRISED OF A BLAZE ORANGE BACKGROUND WITH 6 BLACK LETTERING. 7 THE FEE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF A SNOWMOBILE AS A NON-TRAIL SNOWMOBILE 8 AND EACH RENEWAL THEREOF SHALL BE TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS, FIFTEEN DOLLARS 9 WHICH SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE SNOWMOBILE TRAIL DEVELOPMENT AND 10 MAINTENANCE FUND SET FORTH IN SECTION 21.07 OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION LAW. 11
- 12 S 2. Section 2230 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding 13 a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
- 14 PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF SUBDIVISION TWO-A OF 15 SECTION TWENTY-TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO OF THIS ARTICLE SHALL BE GUILTY OF A VIOLATION PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS 16 FOR EACH 17 OFFENSE, OF WHICH FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS OF SUCH FINE SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE SNOWMOBILE TRAIL DEVELOPMENT AND MAINTENANCE FUND SET 18 SECTION 21.07 OF THE PARKS, RECREATION AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION LAW. IN 19 ADDITION TO SUCH FINE, ANY SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT OFFENSE WITHIN A FIVE 20 21 YEAR PERIOD SHALL RESULT IN THE SUSPENSION OF ALL LICENSES SET FORTH 22 SECTION 11-0701 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW HELD BY SUCH
- 24 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
