CROCI -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs -- reported favorably from said committee, ordered to first and second report, ordered to a third reading, passed by Senate and delivered to the Assembly, recalled, vote reconsidered, restored to third reading, amended and ordered reprinted, retaining its place in the order of third reading -- recommitted to the Committee on Veterans, Homeland Security and Military Affairs in accordance with Senate Rule 6, sec. 8 -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to amend the executive law and the public health law, in relation to health care options for veterans

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 353 of the executive law is amended by adding a new  
2     subdivision 23 to read as follows:  
3     23. TO MAINTAIN A FACT SHEET ON THE DIVISION'S WEBPAGE CONTAINING (A)  
4     CONTACT INFORMATION FOR ALL VETERANS INTEGRATED SERVICE NETWORKS LOCATED  
5     WITHIN THE STATE AND (B) CURRENT CONTACT INFORMATION FOR THE UNITED  
6     STATES VETERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION. THE FACT SHEET SHALL BE ENTITLED,  
7     "INFORMATION FOR VETERANS CONCERNING HEALTH CARE OPTIONS" AND SHALL BE  
8     UPDATED ANNUALLY.  
9     S 2. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 2803-u  
10    to read as follows:  
11    S 2803-U. DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION FOR VETERANS CONCERNING HEALTH  
12    CARE OPTIONS. 1. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:  
13    "INFORMATION FOR VETERANS CONCERNING HEALTH CARE OPTIONS" SHALL MEAN  
14    THE FACT SHEET MAINTAINED BY THE DIVISION OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS PURSUANT  
15    TO SUBDIVISION TWENTY-THREE OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-THREE OF THE  
16    EXECUTIVE LAW.

1       2. UPON ADMISSION TO A HOSPITAL, EACH PATIENT SHALL BE ASKED IF THEY  
2 HAVE SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES. IF THE PATIENT RESPONDS  
3 IN THE AFFIRMATIVE, THE HOSPITAL MUST PROVIDE THE PATIENT WITH A COPY OF  
4 THE "INFORMATION FOR VETERANS CONCERNING HEALTH CARE OPTIONS" FACT  
5 SHEET, PRIOR TO DISCHARGING THE PATIENT.

6       3. NO CAUSE OF ACTION OF ANY NATURE OR KIND ARISING OUT OF A FAILURE  
7 TO GIVE OR RECEIVE THE NOTICE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL ACCRUE TO  
8 ANY PERSON AGAINST THE STATE OR ANY SUBDIVISION OR AGENCY THEREOF OR ANY  
9 HOSPITAL.

10      S 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that  
11 section one of this act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it  
12 shall have become a law; and provided further that section two of this  
13 act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after it shall  
14 have become a law.
