AN ACT to amend the civil service law, in relation to civil service credits for step children of firefighters, police officers, emergency medical technicians and paramedics killed in the line of duty

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 85-a of the civil service law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:
- 3 (C) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "CHILD" SHALL INCLUDE A 4 STEP CHILD OF OR THE CHILD OF A SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A FIREFIGHTER, 5 POLICE OFFICER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN OR PARAMEDIC KILLED IN THE 6 LINE OF DUTY.

- S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 85-b of the civil service law, as amended by chapter 376 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 1. [Definition] DEFINITIONS. (A) As used in this section, "killed in the line of duty" shall mean having died in the performance of duty as the natural and proximate result of the World Trade Center attack on September eleventh, two thousand one or as the natural and proximate result of participation in the rescue effort that was conducted in response to such attack.
- 16 (B) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, THE TERM "CHILD" SHALL INCLUDE A 17 STEP CHILD OF OR THE CHILD OF A SURVIVING SPOUSE OF A FIREFIGHTER, 18 POLICE OFFICER, EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN OR PARAMEDIC KILLED IN THE 19 LINE OF DUTY.
- 20 S 3. Subdivision 1 of section 85-c of the civil service law is amended 21 by adding a new paragraph (c) to read as follows:
