AN ACT to amend the public service law, in relation to providing for the notification of impending emergencies by electric corporations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The public service law is amended by adding a new section 54 to read as follows:

- S 54. NOTIFICATION OF IMPENDING EMERGENCIES. 1. EVERY ELECTRIC CORPORATION SHALL NOTIFY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF A MUNICIPALITY OR THE DESIGNATED AGENCY HEAD OR DEPARTMENT HEAD OF A MUNICIPALITY WHEN THERE IS AN IMPENDING ELECTRICAL EMERGENCY THAT MAY AFFECT THE MUNICIPALITY. EACH MUNICIPALITY NOTIFIED OF A PENDING ELECTRICAL EMERGENCY SHALL PROVIDE APPROPRIATE NOTICE AND INFORMATION TO DESIGNATED MEDIA OUTLETS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ELECTRONIC, PRINT, INTERNET OR OTHER DESIGNATED PUBLIC MEDIA OUTLETS SERVING SUCH AFFECTED MUNICIPALITY.
- 2. (A) THE COMMISSION, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, SHALL PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. THE COMMISSION SHALL SOLICIT INPUT FROM ELECTRIC CORPORATIONS AND MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS IN THE PROCESS OF FORMULATING SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS.
- 16 (B) SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL INCLUDE BUT NOTBELIMITED TO 17 ESTABLISHING PROTOCOLS WHICH ADDRESS THE MAGNITUDE AND SEVERITY OF THE PROTOCOLS 18 IMPENDING EMERGENCY, AS WELL AS FOR NOTIFICATION OF THE 19 PUBLIC.
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 21 it shall have become a law.
