AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to eliminating defenses for  
patronizing a prostitute in the first degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY,  
DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 230.07 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 74  
2     of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:  
3     S 230.07 Patronizing a prostitute; defense.  
4     In any prosecution for patronizing a prostitute in the [first or]  
5     second [degrees] OR THIRD DEGREE, it is a defense that the defendant did  
6     not have reasonable grounds to believe that the person was less than the  
7     age specified.  
8     S 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
9     have become a law.

[ ] is old law to be omitted.
