AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to common core curriculum examinations

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 208-b 2 to read as follows:
- 208-B. COMMON CORE CURRICULUM EXAMINATIONS. THE DEPARTMENT AND ALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS SHALL CEASE TO USE EXAMINATIONS DEVELOPED BY 5 EDUCATION, INC. OR ITS AFFILIATES AND TERMINATE ITS CONTRACTS WITH PEAR-EDUCATION, INC. OR ITS AFFILIATES TO PLAN, CONSULT, DEVELOP, 7 PROVIDE, ADMINISTER, OR REVIEW NEW YORK STATE COMMON CORE STANDARDIZED TESTS. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ENTER INTO ANY NEW AGREEMENTS WITH PEAR-8 9 EDUCATION, INC. OR ITS AFFILIATES FOR THE PURPOSES OF DEVELOPING CURRICULUM, OR TESTS WHETHER STANDARDIZED OR NOT, PURCHASING 10 TESTS OR
- 11 ANY EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS.
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of September next 13 succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law.
