AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to fees for the registration or reregistration of an agricultural trailer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 8 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 13 of part G of chapter 59 of the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

a. The provisions of this chapter in relation to registration books and registration, certificates of registration, number plates, duplicates of certificates and number plates, times of registration and reregistration and the duration thereof, for motor vehicles, shall apply also to trailers. The following fees shall be paid upon the registration or reregistration of a trailer, other than a coach or house trailer or a semitrailer, in accordance with the provisions of this article: The annual fee of five dollars and thirty-nine cents for each five hundred pounds or fraction thereof of maximum gross weight but in no case shall the annual fee be less than fourteen dollars and thirty-eight cents. The following fees shall be paid upon the registration or reregistration of a coach or house trailer in accordance with the provisions of this article: The annual fee of one dollar and seventy-three cents for each one hundred pounds or major fraction thereof of unladen weight but case shall the annual fee be less than twenty-one dollars and fifty-sevcents. THE FOLLOWING FEES SHALL BE PAID UPON THE REGISTRATION OR REREGISTRATION OF AN AGRICULTURAL IN ACCORDANCE TRAILER, THIS ARTICLE: THE ANNUAL FEE OF TWO DOLLARS AND SEVENTY PROVISIONS OF CENTS FOR EACH FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS OR FRACTION THEREOF OF MAXIMUM NO CASE SHALL THE ANNUAL FEE BE LESS THAN SEVEN DOLLARS WEIGHT BUT IN

AND NINETEEN CENTS. FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS PARAGRAPH, "AGRICULTURAL TRAILER" SHALL MEAN A TRAILER OWNED BY A PERSON ENGAGED IN PRODUCTION BY 3 MEANS OF (I) THE PLANTING, CULTIVATION AND HARVESTING OF AGRICULTURAL, AND FOOD PRODUCTS OF THE SOIL, INCLUDING HORTICULTURAL 5 SPECIALTIES SUCH AS NURSING STOCK, ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS, ORNAMENTAL 6 (II) THE RAISING, FEEDING AND CARE OF LIVESTOCK, BEES AND FLOWERS, 7 POULTRY OR (III) DAIRY FARMING. A TRAILER REGISTERED AS AN "AGRICULTURAL 8 TRAILER" UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE OPERATED ON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN THIS PARAGRAPH. SUCH AGRICULTURAL 9 10 TRAILER SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF HIS OR 11 AGRICULTURAL OR DAIRY COMMODITIES OR SUPPLIES OR USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH LUMBERING OPERATIONS CONNECTED WITH BUT ONLY 12 INCIDENTAL OPERATION OF A FARM. The following fees shall be paid upon the registra-13 14 tion or reregistration of a semitrailer in accordance with provisions of 15 this article: The annual fee of twenty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents. However, upon the request of the applicant upon the registration 16 renewal of a registration of a nineteen hundred eighty-nine or later 17 model year semitrailer, such semitrailer may be registered for a period 18 19 not less than five and one-half nor more than six and one-half years for a fee of eighty-six dollars and twenty-five cents. A semitrailer, 20 21 used with any device for converting it to a trailer, other than one 22 being drawn by a tractor semitrailer combination as part of a double 23 tandem combination, shall be registered as a trailer. 24

For the purposes of this paragraph, the unladen weight of a coach or house trailer shall include the weight of any equipment permanently attached to or installed in such trailer. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions and pursuant to regulations and limitations to be established by the commissioner and upon payment of a fee of two dollars and thirty cents therefor a temporary permit to move a coach or house trailer on the public highways from one site to another shall be issued to the owner thereof upon application therefor. Such application shall be made in the manner prescribed by the commissioner.
