## IN SENATE

- Introduced by Sen. LANZA -- read twice and ordered printed, and when printed to be committed to the Committee on Crime Victims, Crime and Correction
- AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to in-person appearance requirements for level two sex offenders

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (b-2) and (b-3) of subdivision 2 of section 2 168-f of the correction law, as added by section 2 of part 0 of chapter 3 56 of the laws of 2005, are amended to read as follows:

4 (b-2) If the sex offender has been given a level TWO OR LEVEL three 5 designation, he or she shall personally appear at the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction within twenty days of the first anniversary 6 7 of the sex offender's initial registration and every year thereafter 8 during the period of registration for the purpose of providing a current photograph of such offender. The law enforcement agency having jurisdic-9 tion shall photograph the sex offender and shall promptly forward a copy 10 such photograph to the division. For purposes of this paragraph, if 11 of such sex offender is confined in a state or local correctional facility, 12 the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction shall be the ward-13 sheriff or other person in charge of the state or 14 superintendent, en, 15 local correctional facility.

16 (b-3) If the sex offender has been given a level one [or level two] designation, he or she shall personally appear at the law enforcement 17 18 agency having jurisdiction within twenty days of the third anniversary the sex offender's initial registration and every three years there-19 of after during the period of registration for the purpose of providing a 20 current photograph of such offender. The law enforcement agency having 21 22 jurisdiction shall photograph the sex offender and shall promptly forward a copy of such photograph to the division. For purposes of this 23 24 paragraph, if such sex offender is confined in a state or local correc-

1 tional facility, the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction 2 shall be the warden, superintendent, sheriff or other person in charge 3 of the state or local correctional facility. 4 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-

5 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
