AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to monthly claim reports for certain disaster assistance; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 29-k
2 to read as follows:

3 S 29-K. MONTHLY CLAIM REPORTS. 1. THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, IN COOP-
4 ERATION WITH THE COMMISSIONER OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY
5 SERVICES, AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STORM
6 RECOVERY, SHALL PRODUCE A MONTHLY REPORT, WHICH SHALL DETAIL THE CLAIMS,
7 AND STATUS OF ALL SUCH CLAIMS, FOR DISASTER ASSISTANCE, AND WHICH ARE
8 PRESENTLY PENDING BEFORE, OR BEING ASSISTED BY, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF
9 STORM RECOVERY AND/OR THE NEW YORK RISING COMMUNITY RECONSTRUCTION PLANS
10 PROGRAM. THE REPORT SHALL FURTHER DETAIL ALL THE ACTIVITIES DURING THE
11 PREVIOUS MONTH OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STORM RECOVERY AND THE NEW
12 YORK RISING COMMUNITY RECONSTRUCTION PLANS PROGRAM. THE FIRST REPORT
13 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE DELIVERED BY DECEMBER FIRST,
14 TWO THOUSAND FIFTEEN, WITH NEW, UPDATED REPORTS BEING DELIVERED ON EACH
15 FIRST DAY OF EVERY MONTH THEREAFTER. THE REPORT SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE
16 TEMPORARY PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE ASSEMBLY, THE
17 CHAIR OF THE SENATE STANDING COMMITTEE ON VETERANS, HOMELAND SECURITY
18 AND MILITARY AFFAIRS, AND THE CHAIR OF THE ASSEMBLY STANDING COMMITTEE
19 ON GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS.

20 2. DURING THE PREPARATION OF EACH REPORT REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION ONE
21 OF THIS SECTION, AND AFTER ITS DELIVERY TO THE PERSONS IDENTIFIED TO
22 RECEIVE SUCH REPORT, THE GOVERNOR, THE COMMISSIONER OF HOMELAND SECURITY
23 AND EMERGENCY SERVICES, AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE GOVERNOR'S

1 OFFICE OF STORM RECOVERY, AS WELL AS THE OFFICES AND DIVISIONS UNDER
2 THEIR DIRECTION, SHALL PROVIDE TO SUCH PERSONS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE
3 REPORTS REQUIRED BY SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION, ANY AND ALL ADDI-
4 TIONAL INFORMATION SUCH PERSONS MAY REQUEST, WITH RESPECT TO ANY ISSUE
5 CONCERNING THE CLAIMS, THE STATUS OF ALL CLAIMS PRESENTLY PENDING
6 BEFORE, OR BEING ASSISTED BY, THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STORM RECOVERY
7 AND THE NEW YORK RISING COMMUNITY RECONSTRUCTION PLANS PROGRAM, OR
8 CONCERNING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF STORM RECOVERY
9 AND/OR THE NEW YORK RISING COMMUNITY RECONSTRUCTION PLANS PROGRAM.
10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be
11 deemed repealed December 2, 2019.
