AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to affirmative defenses to strangulation and related offenses

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Section 121.14 of the penal law, as added by chapter 405 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 S 121.14 [Medical or dental purpose] AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES.
- For purposes of sections 121.11, 121.12 and 121.13 of this article, it shall be an affirmative defense that:
- 6 1. the defendant performed such conduct for a valid medical or dental 7 purpose; OR
- 8 2. THE DEFENDANT PERFORMED SUCH CONDUCT WHILE ENGAGED IN INSTRUCTION 9 OR ATHLETIC COMPETITION OF JUDO, JIU JITSU, BRAZILIAN JIU JITSU OR AIKI-10 DO.
- 11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
