AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to providing an exemption from jury duty for pregnant and breastfeeding women

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Paragraph 2 of subdivision (a) of section 517 of the judiciary law, as added by chapter 86 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as follows:
- (2) An application for postponement of jury service shall be granted 5 hereunder provided: (i) such service has not already been postponed or excused, (ii) the application is made at such time and in such manner as the commissioner of jurors requires, [and] (iii) the postponement is to 7 a date certain when the court is in session not more than six months 8 9 after the date on which such service otherwise is to commence and such date is selected by the prospective juror, AND (IV) THE PROSPECTIVE 10 JUROR IS AN EXPECTING MOTHER AND SIX MONTHS OR MORE PREGNANT, HAVING 11 HEALTH COMPLICATIONS AS A RESULT OF HER PREGNANCY, OR IS A BREASTFEEDING 12 MOTHER. TO GRANT AN APPLICATION FOR POSTPONEMENT OF JURY 13 14 SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE PROSPECTIVE JUROR MUST SUBMIT A NOTE FROM A PHYSICIAN. 15
- 16 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
