AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to providing a "None of the Above" option on ballots in certain uncontested elections

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 7-116 of the election law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 2-a to read as follows:
- 2-A. IN EVERY UNCONTESTED STATEWIDE, SENATE OR ASSEMBLY ELECTION, THE OFFICER OR BOARD WHO OR WHICH PREPARES THE BALLOT SHALL PLACE BELOW THE CANDIDATE LISTED FOR ELECTION AN OPTION WHICH A VOTER MAY SELECT THAT SHALL READ: NONE OF THE ABOVE.
- 7 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
