- AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to permitting class A-1 and B-1 distilleries to sell liquor manufactured by the licensee for consumption on the premises

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 61 of the alcoholic beverage control law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-b to read as follows:

3 THE HOLDER OF A CLASS A-1 OR B-1 DISTILLERY LICENSE MAY SELL AT 1-в. 4 RETAIL BY THE BOTTLE OR FOR CONSUMPTION ON THELICENSED PREMISES ANY 5 LIOUOR MANUFACTURED BY THE LICENSEE. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE LICENSEE 6 SHALL REGULARLY KEEP FOOD AVAILABLE FOR SALE OR SERVICE то ITS RETAIL 7 PREMISES.
