AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to adopting local laws to regulate taxicabs and limousines in the county of Suffolk

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 2 of section 181 of the general municipal law, subdivision 1 as separately amended by chapters 382 and 385 of
2 the laws of 2012 and subdivision 2 as added by chapter 579 of the laws
3 of 1993, are amended to read as follows:

5 1. The registration and licensing of taxicabs and may limit the number
6 of taxicabs to be licensed and the county of Westchester may adopt ordinances regulating the registration and licensing of taxicabs and limousines and may limit the number to be licensed; the county of Nassau may
7 adopt ordinances regulating the registration of taxicabs and limousines;
8 and the county of Suffolk may adopt LOCAL LAWS OR ordinances regulating
9 the registration of taxicabs, limousines, and livery vehicles; and the
10 county of Rockland may adopt local laws or ordinances regulating the
11 registration and licensing of taxicabs, limousines, and livery vehicles
12 and may limit the number to be licensed.

14 2. Parking and passenger pick-up and discharge by taxicabs, limousines
15 and livery vehicles. Establishment of such LOCAL LAWS OR ordinances and
16 regulations regulating parking and passenger pick-up and discharges may
17 be based upon recommendations from municipal planning officials or other
18 public entities and may address and take into consideration such
19 factors, including, but not limited to, geographic areas, vehicle type,
20 limiting the number of parked vehicles and activities undertaken while
21 parked, and periods of idling.

23 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
