- AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of making a terroristic threat against a police officer

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.21 to 2 read as follows:

3 S 490.21 MAKING A TERRORISTIC THREAT AGAINST A POLICE OFFICER.

A PERSON IS GUILTY OF MAKING A TERRORISTIC THREAT AGAINST A POLICE 4 1. 5 OFFICER WHEN WITH INTENT TO INTIMIDATE OR COERCE A CIVILIAN POPULATION, 6 POLICY OF A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT BY INTIMIDATION OR COER-INFLUENCE THE 7 CION, OR AFFECT THE CONDUCT OF A UNIT OF GOVERNMENT BY MURDER, ASSASSI-8 OR KIDNAPPING, HE OR SHE THREATENS TO COMMIT OR CAUSE TO BE NATION COMMITTED A SPECIFIED OFFENSE AGAINST A POLICE OFFICER AND THEREBY CAUS-9 ES A REASONABLE EXPECTATION OR FEAR OF THE IMMINENT COMMISSION OF 10 SUCH OFFENSE AGAINST A POLICE OFFICER. 11

12 2. IT SHALL BE NO DEFENSE TO A PROSECUTION PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION 13 THAT THE DEFENDANT DID NOT HAVE THE INTENT OR CAPABILITY OF COMMITTING 14 THE SPECIFIED OFFENSE OR THAT THE THREAT WAS NOT MADE TO A PERSON WHO 15 WAS A SUBJECT THEREOF.

16 MAKING A TERRORISTIC THREAT AGAINST A POLICE OFFICER IS A CLASS C 17 FELONY.

18 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
