AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to certified school psychologists and special education services and programs for preschool children with handicapping conditions; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph d of subdivision 6 of section 4410 of the education law, as added by chapter 581 of the laws of 2011, is amended to read as follows:

- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the 5 exemption in subdivision one of section seventy-six hundred five of this chapter shall apply to persons employed [by] ON A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME 6 SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, WEEKLY, OR MONTHLY BASIS, 7 ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON IS 9 EMPLOYED BY AND UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF a center-based program approved pursuant to subdivision nine of this section as a CERTIFIED 10 school psychologist to provide activities, services and use of the title 11 12 psychologist to students enrolled in such approved center-based program; AND TO CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS EMPLOYED ON A FULL-TIME OR 13 PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, 14 WEEKLY, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT 15 MONTHLY BASIS, THE SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS EMPLOYED BY AND 16 UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF A PROGRAM THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH B OF 17 18 SUBDIVISION NINE OF THIS SECTION, OR SUBDIVISION NINE-A OF THIS SECTION,

- S 2. Subdivision 1 of section 7605 of the education law, as added by chapter 987 of the laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

The activities, services, and use of the title of psychologist, or 17 18 any derivation thereof, on the part of a person in the employ of a 19 federal, state, county or municipal agency, or other political subdivision, or a chartered elementary or secondary school or degree-granting 20 21 educational institution insofar as such activities and services are a part of the duties of his salaried position; OR ON THE PART OF A PERSON IN THE EMPLOY AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST ON A FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, WEEKLY, OR 23 24 25 MONTHLY BASIS, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON EMPLOYED AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS 26 EMPLOYED BY THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF A PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION 27 AND UNDER PROGRAM APPROVED PURSUANT TO PARAGRAPH B OF SUBDIVISION NINE OR SUBDIVI-28 SION NINE-A OF SECTION FORTY-FOUR HUNDRED TEN OF THIS CHAPTER TO PROVIDE 29 30 ACTIVITIES, SERVICES AND TO USE THE TITLE "CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOL-OGIST", SO LONG AS THIS SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PERMIT THE USE OF THE 31 32 TITLE "LICENSED PSYCHOLOGIST", TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SUCH APPROVED 33 PROGRAM OR TO CONDUCT A MULTIDISCIPLINARY EVALUATION OF A PRESCHOOL CHILD HAVING OR SUSPECTED OF HAVING A DISABILITY; OR ON THE PART 34 35 THE EMPLOY AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST ON A FULL-TIME PERSON IN OR PART-TIME SALARY BASIS, WHICH MAY INCLUDE ON AN HOURLY, 36 37 MONTHLY BASIS, OR ON A FEE FOR EVALUATION SERVICES BASIS PROVIDED THAT 38 SUCH PERSON EMPLOYED AS A CERTIFIED SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST IS EMPLOYED BY UNDER THE DOMINION AND CONTROL OF AN AGENCY APPROVED IN ACCORDANCE 39 40 WITH TITLE TWO-A OF ARTICLE TWENTY-FIVE OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM MULTIDISCIPLINARY 41 DELIVER EVALUATIONS, SERVICE COORDINATION SERVICES AND EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM 42 SERVICES, 43 WHERE EACH SUCH PRESCHOOL SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAM OR EARLY INTER-44 VENTION PROVIDER IS AUTHORIZED BY PARAGRAPH A OR B OF SUBDIVISION SIX OF 45 SECTION SIXTY-FIVE HUNDRED THREE OF THIS TITLE, EACH IN THE COURSE THEIR EMPLOYMENT. - S 3. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on and after July 1, 2014, provided, however that the provisions of this act shall expire and be deemed repealed June 30, 2016.
