AN ACT authorizing the county of Saratoga and the Saratoga Water Authority to transfer certain lands

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding section 219 of the county law to the contrary, the county of Saratoga, is hereby authorized, acting by and through its county board of supervisors and upon such terms and conditions as determined by such board of supervisors, to discontinue the use of the lands described in section two of this act acquired for reforestation purposes. The authorization contained in this act shall be effective only upon acquisition by the county of Saratoga of the parcel as described in section three of this act, which is currently vacant property not used by the public for recreational or reforestation purposes, for reforestation purposes.

S 2. The real property authorized to be conveyed by the county of Saratoga pursuant to section one of this act is described as follows:

All that parcel of land located in the county of Saratoga and state of New York bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point at the intersection of the southeasterly boundary of Butler Road with the division line between the lands of The Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the south and the lands of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (Liber 333 Page 306) on the north, said point being marked by a capped iron rod labeled "CT Male"; thence running generally in a southwesterly direction along the southerly bounds of Butler Road S56°-51'-55W (455.07) feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence from said POINT OF BEGINNING running generally in a southeasterly direction along the division line between The Saratoga

S 3. The authorization provided in section one of this act shall be effective only upon the condition that on or before the alienation and conveyance of lands described in section two of this act, the county of Saratoga shall acquire the following real property:

All that parcel located in the county of Saratoga and state of New York bounded and described as follows:

Commencing at a point at the intersection of the southeasterly boundary of Butler Road with the division line between the lands of The Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the south and the lands of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (Liber 333 Page the north, said point being marked by a capped iron rod labeled "CT Male"; thence running generally in a southeasterly direction along line of The Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the south and the lands of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (Liber 333 Page 306) on the north S80°-05'-11"E (113.23) feet to a point marked by an iron pipe; thence running generally in a southeasterly direction along the division line of The Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the southwest and the lands of River Galusha, LLC (Liber 1784 Page 708) on the northeast S25°-36'-20"E feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence from said POINT OF (1149.05)BEGINNING running generally in a southeasterly direction along the division line of River Galusha, LLC (Liber 1784 Page 708) on the northeast the Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the southwest  $S25^{\circ}-36'-20$ "E (370.00) feet to a point marked by a capped iron rod labeled "CT Male"; thence running in a generally southwesterly direction along the division line between The Saratoga County Water 2008010290) on the northwest and the County Authority (Instrument No. of Saratoga (Liber 375 Page 429) on the southeast S64°-23'-40W feet to a point marked with a capped iron rod labeled "CT Male"; thence running in a generally northwesterly direction along the division between The Saratoga County Water Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) on the northeast and the County of Saratoga (Liber 375 Page 429) on the southwest N25°-36'-20W (370.00) feet to a point; thence running in a generally northeasterly direction through the lands of The Saratoga Authority (Instrument No. 2008010290) N64°-23'-40"E County Water (600.00) to the point and place of beginning; containing 5.096 acres of land, more or less.

S 4. Notwithstanding the failure of the county of Saratoga to seek or receive state legislative authorization to alienate certain parklands as described in section two of this act prior to the parklands used by the Saratoga County Water Authority, such alienation is hereby validated, legalized, ratified and confirmed.

S 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
