AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to establishing the department of health as the agency to provide proof of Medicaid eligibility when requested by a recipient or his or her designated representative

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 366-a of the social services law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:
- 3 3-A. THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SHALL RESPOND TO A REQUEST WITHIN THIRTY DAYS AND IT SHALL BE THE SINGLE STATE AGENCY REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY ON OFFICIAL DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH LETTERHEAD WHEN REQUESTED BY A RECIPIENT OR HIS OR HER DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE,
- 7 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LEGAL COUNSEL, LEGAL GUARDIAN, OR ATTOR-
- 8 NEY-IN-FACT UNDER A POWER OF ATTORNEY.
- 9 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
