AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the "defend our homes act providing exemptions for ammunition feeding device capacity in homes; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "defend our 1 homes act". 2
- 3 S 2. Subdivision a of section 265.20 of the penal law is amended by adding a new paragraph 3-a to read as follows:

- 3-A. POSSESSION OF A MAGAZINE OR SIMILAR AMMUNITION FEEDING CONTAINS MORE THAN SEVEN ROUNDS OF AMMUNITION, BUT THAT DOES NOT HAVE A CAPACITY OF OR CAN READILY BE RESTORED OR CONVERTED TO ACCEPT THAN TEN ROUNDS, IN A SAFE STORAGE DEPOSITORY, AS DEFINED IN MORE SECTION 265.45 OF THIS ARTICLE, IN THE HOME OF THEPOSSESSOR 10 PROTECTION OF A PERSON OR PROPERTY.
- 3. The second undesignated paragraph of section 265.37 of the penal 11 12 law is REPEALED.
- 13 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to have been in full force and effect on March 16, 2013. 14
