AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, relation to requiring an educational awareness campaign relative to the dangers of acting as a pedestrian while distracted by using a mobile device

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding a new section 19-193 to read as follows: 2
- 19-193 PEDESTRIAN WHILE DISTRACTED BY PROGRAM. 1. THE TEXTING COMMISSIONER SHALL DEVELOP AN AWARENESS CAMPAIGN THAT WILL 5 PEDESTRIANS OF THE DANGERS OF ACTING AS A PEDESTRIAN WHILE DISTRACTED BY 6 TEXTING, OR OTHER USE OF A MOBILE DEVICE. THE CAMPAIGN SHALL FOCUS ON EDUCATING PEDESTRIANS ABOUT THE DANGERS OF "USING A MOBILE DEVICE" WHILE 7 CROSSING AN INTERSECTION AND/OR "USING A MOBILE DEVICE" WHILE BEING NEAR 8 9 OR IN A STREET.
- 10 2. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP THE CAMPAIGN AND SHALL HAVE LEAVE TO DECIDE HOW BEST TO CARRY OUT THE CAMPAIGN. 11
- 12 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
