AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the state smart growth public infrastructure criteria

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 6-0107 of the environmental 2 conservation law, as added by chapter 433 of the laws of 2010, is 3 amended to read as follows:
- 1. In addition to meeting other criteria and requirements of 5 governing approval, development, financing and state aid for construction of new or expanded public infrastructure or the reconstruction thereof, no state infrastructure agency shall approve, undertake, support or finance a public infrastructure project, including providing grants, awards, loans or assistance programs, unless, to the 8 9 10 extent practicable, it is consistent with the relevant criteria specified in subdivision two of this section. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS 11 THIS SUBDIVISION OR ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE TO THE 12 13 PROJECTS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, REPAIR CONTRARY, SCHOOL FACILITIES OR EXISTING LIBRARY 14 IMPROVEMENT OF EXISTING PUBLIC 15 FACILITIES, AND PROJECTS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW OR EXPANDED 16 SCHOOL OR LIBRARY FACILITIES IN CITIES HAVING A POPULATION OF ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND INHABITANTS OR MORE, SHALL NOT BE DEEMED 17 18 PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ARTI-19 CLE.
- 20 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
