AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to the appointment of members of the battery park city authority

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 1973 of the public authorities law, as amended by chapter 766 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows:

- (1) There is hereby created the battery park city authority which shall be a body corporate and politic, constituting a public benefit 5 6 corporation. Its membership shall consist of seven members 7 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate. 8 THAN A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE AUTHORITY ARE RESIDENTS OF LESS THE COMMUNITY DISTRICT IN WHICH BATTERY PARK CITY IS LOCATED, THE GOVER-9 10 NOR SHALL APPOINT A RESIDENT OF THE COMMUNITY DISTRICT IN WHICH PARK CITY IS LOCATED. One of the members first appointed shall serve for 11 a term ending four years from January first next succeeding his appoint-12 13 one of such members shall serve for a term ending five years from such date; and one of such members shall serve for a term ending 14 years from such date. Provided, however, that two board members first appointed on or after the effective date of [the] chapter SEVEN HUNDRED 15 16 SIXTY-SIX of the laws of two thousand five [which amended this subdivi-17 18 sion] shall serve an initial term of two years; provided further that 19 two other board members first appointed on or after the effective date of [the] chapter SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SIX of the laws 20 of two 21 subdivision] shall serve an initial term of [which amended this four years. Their successors shall serve for terms of 22 six years each. Members shall continue in office until their successors have been 23 24 appointed and qualified and the provisions of section thirty-nine of the 25 public officers law shall apply. In the event of a vacancy occurring in 26 the office of a member by death, resignation or otherwise, the governor shall appoint a successor with the advice and consent of the senate to 27 serve for the balance of the unexpired term. 28
