AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to coverage for opioid-addiction treatment medications

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subsection (i) of section 3216 of the insurance law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph 33 to read as follows:
 - (33) EVERY POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR OPIOID-ADDICTION TREATMENT MEDICATIONS. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES, PROVIDED THAT THE CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES ARE AT LEAST AS FAVORABLE TO AN INSURED AS THE CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES THAT APPLY TO COVERAGE FOR OTHER PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.
- 11 S 2. Subsection (k) of section 3221 of the insurance law is amended by 12 adding a new paragraph 21 to read as follows:
- 13 (21) EVERY POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY IN THIS STATE THAT 14 PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE 15 AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR
- 16 OPIOID-ADDICTION TREATMENT MEDICATIONS. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO 17 CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES, PROVIDED THAT THE CO-PAYS, COINSU-
- 18 RANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES ARE AT LEAST AS FAVORABLE TO AN INSURED AS THE
- 19 CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES THAT APPLY TO COVERAGE FOR OTHER
- 20 PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

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S 3. Section 4303 of the insurance law is amended by adding a new subsection (qq) to read as follows:

(QQ) EVERY POLICY DELIVERED OR ISSUED FOR DELIVERY IN THIS STATE THAT PROVIDES MEDICAL, MAJOR MEDICAL, OR SIMILAR COMPREHENSIVE-TYPE COVERAGE AND PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR PRESCRIPTION DRUGS SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR OPIOID-ADDICTION TREATMENT MEDICATIONS. SUCH COVERAGE MAY BE SUBJECT TO CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES, PROVIDED THAT THE CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES ARE AT LEAST AS FAVORABLE TO AN INSURED AS THE CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, OR DEDUCTIBLES THAT APPLY TO COVERAGE FOR OTHER PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

11 S 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to any 12 policy issued, delivered, modified, amended, or renewed on or after such 13 effective date.
