- AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to authorizing school districts to order from certain farmers without requiring a waiver

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 9 of section 103 of the gener-2 al municipal law, as amended by chapter 269 of the laws of 2004, is 3 amended to read as follows:

4 (a) (I) such association of producers or growers is comprised of ten 5 or fewer owners of farms who also operate such farms and who have 6 combined to fill the order of a school district as herein authorized, 7 provided however, that a school district may apply to the commissioner 8 of education for permission to purchase from an association of more than 9 ten owners of such farms when no other producers or growers have offered 10 to sell to such school; OR

(II) SUCH ASSOCIATION OF PRODUCERS OR GROWERS IS COMPRISED OF 11 OWNERS OF FARMS WHO ALSO OPERATE SUCH FARMS AND HAVE COMBINED TO FILL THE ORDER 12 13 A SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND WHERE SUCH ORDER IS FOR TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND OF DOLLARS OR LESS AS HEREIN AUTHORIZED, PROVIDED HOWEVER, 14 THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY APPLY TO THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION FOR PERMISSION TO 15 PURCHASE ORDERS OF MORE THAN TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM AN 16 ASSO-CIATION OF OWNERS OF SUCH FARMS WHEN NO OTHER PRODUCERS OR GROWERS HAVE 17 18 OFFERED TO SELL TO SUCH SCHOOL;

19 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
