AN ACT to amend the village law and the public officers law, in relation to waiving the residency requirement for the code/zoning enforcement officer in the village of Aurora, Cayuga county

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3-300 of the village law is amended by adding a new
2 subdivision 26 to read as follows:
3 26. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF THIS CHAPTER OR ANY OTHER GENER-
4 AL LAW, LOCAL LAW, ORDINANCE, OR SPECIAL ACT, THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUS-
5 TEES OF THE INCORPORATED VILLAGE OF AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, MAY, BY
6 RESOLUTION, PROVIDE THAT THE CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER OF THE
7 VILLAGE OF AURORA, CAYUGA COUNTY, NEED NOT BE A RESIDENT OF SUCH
8 VILLAGE, BUT MUST BE A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, STATE OF NEW
9 YORK, OR OF A COUNTY WHICH ADJOINS THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA.
10 S 2. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new
11 subdivision 65 to read as follows:
12 65. IN THE VILLAGE OF AURORA, IN THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA, THE PROVISIONS
13 OF THIS SECTION REQUIRING A PERSON TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE POLITICAL
14 SUBDIVISION OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE FOR WHICH HE OR SHE
15 SHALL BE CHOSEN OR WITHIN WHICH HIS OR HER OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS ARE
16 REQUIRED TO BE EXERCISED SHALL NOT PREVENT A PERSON FROM HOLDING THE
17 OFFICE OF CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, PROVIDED THAT SUCH PERSON
18 RESIDES IN THE COUNTY OF CAYUGA OR AN ADJOINING COUNTY WITHIN THE STATE
19 OF NEW YORK. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THE PERSON PERFORMING THE FUNCTIONS OF
20 CODE/ZONING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN ANY OTHER VILLAGE SHALL BE A RESIDENT
21 OF SUCH VILLAGE, UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW.
22 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
