AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to including the impersonation of a doctor of medicine as criminal impersonation in the second degree

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 190.25 of the penal law is amended by adding a new  
2     subdivision 5 to read as follows:

3     5. IMPERSONATES A DOCTOR OF MEDICINE AND, IN SO DOING, THE ACTOR  
4     PROVIDES MEDICAL ADVICE OR TREATMENT TO ANOTHER PERSON AS A PATIENT,  
5     REGARDLESS OF WHETHER OR NOT THE OTHER PERSON SUFFERS HARM FROM THE  
6     MEDICAL ADVICE OR TREATMENT.

7     S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding  
8     the date on which it shall have become a law.
