THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. Section 73 of the public officers law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 8-c to read as follows:

3 8-C. NOTWITHSTANDING THE PROVISIONS OF SUBPARAGRAPHS (I) AND (II)OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF SUBDIVISION EIGHT OF THIS SECTION, A FORMER STATE OFFI-4 5 CER OR EMPLOYEE WHO, PRIOR TO HIS OR HER SEPARATION FROM STATE SERVICE, б WAS EMPLOYED PERFORMING DIRECT CARE, CLINICAL CARE, CASE MANAGEMENT, 7 SERVICE COORDINATION OR OTHER RELATED SUPPORT DUTIES WITH THE STATE OF NEW YORK IS NOT BARRED FROM RENDERING SUCH SERVICES IN 8 THE FUTURE ТΟ 9 INDIVIDUALS WHO WERE RECEIVING SUCH SERVICES FROM THAT INDIVIDUAL PRIOR TO LEAVING THE STATE SERVICE. 10

11 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
