

1 HELD NOT LESS THAN SIXTY DAYS NOR MORE THAN EIGHTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF
2 CERTIFICATION OF SUFFICIENT SIGNATURES.

3 2. A RECALL ELECTION MAY BE CONDUCTED WITHIN ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY DAYS
4 FROM THE DATE OF CERTIFICATION OF SUFFICIENT SIGNATURES IN ORDER THAT
5 THE ELECTION MAY BE CONSOLIDATED WITH THE NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED
6 ELECTION OCCURRING WHOLLY OR PARTIALLY WITHIN THE SAME JURISDICTION IN
7 WHICH THE RECALL ELECTION IS HELD, IF THE NUMBER OF VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO
8 VOTE AT THAT NEXT REGULARLY SCHEDULED ELECTION EQUAL AT LEAST FIFTY
9 PERCENT OF ALL THE VOTERS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE AT THE RECALL ELECTION.

10 3. IF THE MAJORITY VOTE ON THE QUESTION IS TO RECALL, THE OFFICER IS
11 REMOVED AND, IF THERE IS A CANDIDATE, THE CANDIDATE WHO RECEIVES A
12 PLURALITY IS THE SUCCESSOR. THE OFFICER MAY NOT BE A CANDIDATE, NOR
13 SHALL THERE BE ANY CANDIDACY FOR AN OFFICE FILED PURSUANT TO SECTION TWO
14 OF ARTICLE SIX.

15 S 4. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PROVIDE FOR CIRCULATION, FILING, AND
16 CERTIFICATION OF PETITIONS, NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES, AND THE RECALL
17 ELECTION.

18 S 5. IF RECALL OF THE GOVERNOR OR SECRETARY OF STATE IS INITIATED, THE
19 RECALL DUTIES OF THAT OFFICE SHALL BE PERFORMED BY THE LIEUTENANT GOVER-
20 NOR OR COMPTROLLER, RESPECTIVELY.

21 S 6. A STATE OFFICER OR CITYWIDE OFFICIAL IN A FIRST CLASS CITY WHO IS
22 NOT RECALLED SHALL BE REIMBURSED BY THE STATE OR RESPECTIVE CITY FOR THE
23 OFFICER'S RECALL ELECTION EXPENSES LEGALLY AND PERSONALLY INCURRED.
24 ANOTHER RECALL MAY NOT BE INITIATED AGAINST THE OFFICER UNTIL SIX MONTHS
25 AFTER THE ELECTION.

26 S 7. THE LEGISLATURE SHALL PROVIDE FOR RECALL OF LOCAL OFFICERS. THIS
27 SECTION DOES NOT AFFECT COUNTIES AND CITIES WHOSE CHARTERS PROVIDE FOR
28 RECALL.

29 S 2. Resolved (if the Assembly concur), That the foregoing amendment
30 be referred to the first regular legislative session convening after the
31 next succeeding general election of members of the assembly, and, in
32 conformity with section 1 of article 19 of the constitution, be
33 published for 3 months previous to the time of such election.
