AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to assaults upon station cleaners and terminal cleaners

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 487 of the laws of 2015, is amended to read as follows:

This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeeding the date upon which it shall have become a law; provided, however, if chapter 472 of the laws of 2015 shall not have taken effect on or before such date then section two of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as such chapter of the laws of 2015, takes effect.
