AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to public safety communications surcharges on prepaid wireless telecommunications services; to amend the county law, in relation to wireless surcharges in Hamilton, Jefferson, Lewis, Niagara, Oneida, Oswego, Schoharie, and St. Lawrence County

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEM-BLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Article 28 of the tax law is amended by adding a new part 6 1 2 to read as follows: 3

PART VI

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGE ON PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

SECTION 1155. PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGE ON PREPAID WIRELESS б 7 TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES.

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8 1155. PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGE ON PREPAID WIRELESS S TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES. (A) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, WHERE NOT 9 OTHERWISE SPECIFICALLY DEFINED AND UNLESS A DIFFERENT MEANING IS CLEARLY 10 11 REQUIRED:

12 (1)"CONSUMER" MEANS A PERSON WHO PURCHASES PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOM-13 MUNICATIONS SERVICE IN A RETAIL TRANSACTION.

(2) "SURCHARGE" MEANS THE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGE 14 ON 15 PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES THAT IS REOUIRED TO BE 16 COLLECTED BY A VENDOR FROM A CONSUMER IN THE AMOUNT ESTABLISHED IN 17 SUBDIVISION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

18 (3) "PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE" MEANS A WIRELESS 19 TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE THAT ALLOWS A CALLER TO DIAL 911 TO ACCESS THE 911 SYSTEM, WHICH SERVICE MUST BE PAID FOR IN ADVANCE AND IS SOLD IN 20 PREDETERMINED UNITS OR DOLLARS OF WHICH THE NUMBER DECLINES WITH USE IN 21 22 A KNOWN AMOUNT.

23 (4) "PROVIDER" MEANS A PERSON THAT PROVIDES PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOM-24 MUNICATIONS SERVICE PURSUANT TO A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE FEDERAL COMMUNI-25 CATIONS COMMISSION.

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1 (5) "RETAIL TRANSACTION" MEANS THE PURCHASE OF PREPAID WIRELESS TELE-2 COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE FROM A VENDOR FOR ANY PURPOSE OTHER THAN RESALE. 3 EACH INDIVIDUAL PREPAID TELECOMMUNICATION DEVICE, ADDITION OF MINUTES OR 4 ADDITION OF FUNDS SHALL CONSTITUTE A SEPARATE TRANSACTION.

5 (6) "VENDOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO SELLS PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNI-6 CATIONS SERVICE TO ANOTHER PERSON.

7 (7) "WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE" MEANS COMMERCIAL MOBILE 8 RADIO SERVICE AS DEFINED IN SECTION 20.3 OF TITLE 47 OF THE CODE OF 9 FEDERAL REGULATIONS, AS AMENDED.

(B)(1) A SURCHARGE ON PREPAID WIRELESS COMMUNICATION SERVICE PROVIDED
TO A CONSUMER IS IMPOSED AT A RATE OF ONE DOLLAR PER RETAIL TRANSACTION
OVER TEN DOLLARS, AND THAT RATE WHICH MAY BE IMPOSED BY LOCAL LAW PURSUANT TO SECTION THREE HUNDRED THREE OF THE COUNTY LAW.

14 (2) A VENDOR CONDUCTING A RETAIL TRANSACTION FOR A PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS DEVICE, OR FOR THE ADDITION OF MINUTES OR FUNDS TO A 15 16 PREPAID WIRELESS TELECOMMUNICATIONS DEVICE, SHALL ACT AS A COLLECTION AGENT FOR THE STATE FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE SURCHARGE. THE AMOUNT OF 17 THE SURCHARGE SHALL BE EITHER SEPARATELY STATED ON THE INVOICE, RECEIPT 18 19 OTHER SALES DOCUMENT THAT IS PROVIDED TO THE CONSUMER, OR OTHERWISE OR DISCLOSED TO THE CONSUMER. THE SURCHARGE SHALL BE COLLECTED BY THE 20 21 VENDOR ON ALL POINT OF SALE RETAIL TRANSACTIONS WITHIN NEW YORK STATE, 22 AND FOR ALL INTERNET, PHONE AND OTHER REMOTE RETAIL TRANSACTIONS, OTHER THAN FOR RESALE, THE SURCHARGE SHALL BE COLLECTED WHEN THE BILLING 23 ADDRESS FOR THE PAYMENT METHOD OR THE SHIPPING ADDRESS ARE WITHIN NEW 24 25 YORK STATE.

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE SURCHARGE THAT IS COLLECTED BY A VENDOR FROM A
CONSUMER, IF SUCH AMOUNT IS SEPARATELY STATED ON AN INVOICE, RECEIPT OR
OTHER SALES DOCUMENT PROVIDED TO THE CONSUMER BY THE VENDOR, SHALL NOT
BE INCLUDED IN THE BASE FOR MEASURING ANY TAX, FEE, SURCHARGE, OR OTHER
CHARGE THAT IS IMPOSED BY THIS STATE, ANY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE
STATE, OR ANY INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGENCY.

(4) SURCHARGE RECEIPTS COLLECTED BY VENDORS SHALL BE REMITTED TO THE
COMMISSIONER AT THE SAME TIME AND IN THE SAME MANNER AS PRESCRIBED IN
PART FOUR OF THIS ARTICLE. THOSE PORTIONS OF THE RECEIPTS ATTRIBUTABLE
TO THE SURCHARGE ESTABLISHED UNDER SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED NINETEEN OF
THIS CHAPTER SHALL BE HANDLED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN THE SAME MANNER AS
PRESCRIBED IN SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE OF THIS CHAPTER.

(5) EACH VENDOR IS ENTITLED TO RETAIN, AS AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, AN
AMOUNT EQUAL TO TWO PERCENT OF FIFTY-EIGHT AND THREE-TENTHS PERCENT OF
THE TOTAL COLLECTIONS OF THE SURCHARGE IMPOSED BY THIS SECTION, PROVIDED
THAT THE VENDOR FILES ANY REQUIRED RETURN AND REMITS THE SURCHARGE DUE
TO THE COMMISSIONER ON OR BEFORE ITS DUE DATE.

43 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, (6) ALL SURCHARGE MONIES COLLECTED AND RECEIVED BY THE COMMISSIONER UNDER THIS 44 45 SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED DAILY TO THE CREDIT OF THE COMPTROLLER WITH THOSE RESPONSIBLE BANKS, BANKING HOUSES OR TRUST COMPANIES THE COMP-46 47 TROLLER MAY DESIGNATE. THOSE DEPOSITS SHALL BE KEPT SEPARATE AND APART 48 FROM ALL OTHER MONIES IN THE POSSESSION OF THE COMPTROLLER. THE COMP-49 TROLLER SHALL REQUIRE ADEQUATE SECURITY FROM ALL SUCH DEPOSITORIES. The tax law is amended by adding a new section 1219 to read as 1 S 2. 2 follows: 3 SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SURCHARGE ON PREPAID WIRELESS S 1219. PUBLIC 4 TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES. SUCH LOCAL LAW MAY AUTHORIZE THE 19 SERVICE SUPPLIER TO BEGIN BILLING ITS CUSTOMERS FOR SUCH SURCHARGE PRIOR 20 TO THE DATE THE E911 SYSTEM SERVICE IS TO BEGIN. 21 (C) ANY VENDOR WITHIN A MUNICIPALITY WHICH HAS IMPOSED A SURCHARGE 22 PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE GIVEN A MINIMUM OF 23 FORTY-FIVE DAYS WRITTEN NOTICE PRIOR TO THE DATE IT SHALL BEGIN TO ADD 24 SUCH SURCHARGE TO RETAIL TRANSACTIONS OF ITS CUSTOMERS OR PRIOR ΤO ANY 25 MODIFICATION TO OR CHANGE IN THE SURCHARGE AMOUNT. 26 (D) THE SURCHARGE PROVIDED FOR HEREIN SHALL BE COLLECTED PURSUANT TO 27 SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER. 28 S 3. Subdivision (a) of section 1261 of the tax law, as amended by 29 chapter 182 of the laws of 2005, is amended to read as follows: (a) All taxes, penalties and interest imposed by cities, counties or 30 school districts under the authority of section twelve hundred ten, 31 32 twelve hundred eleven, twelve hundred twelve [or], twelve hundred 33 TWELVE HUNDRED NINETEEN of this article, twelve-A, OR which are 34 collected by the commissioner, shall be deposited daily with such responsible banks, banking houses or trust companies, as may be desig-35 nated by the state comptroller, to the credit of the comptroller, in 36 37 trust for the cities, counties or school districts imposing the tax or 38 (i) the Nassau county interim finance authority or (ii) the Buffalo for fiscal stability authority or (iii) the Erie county fiscal stability 39 40 authority, created by the public authorities law, (i) to the extent that collections from taxes imposed by Nassau county are payable to the 41 net Nassau county interim finance authority or (ii) to the extent that net 42 43 collections from taxes imposed by Erie county or by the city of Buffalo 44 are payable to the Buffalo fiscal stability authority or (iii) to the 45 extent that net collections from taxes imposed by Erie county are payable to the Erie county fiscal stability authority, or for any public 46 47 corporation to which the tax may be payable pursuant to law. benefit 48 Such deposits and deposits received pursuant to subdivision (b) of section twelve hundred fifty-two of this article shall be kept in trust 49 50 and separate and apart from all other monies in the possession of the 51 comptroller. EACH WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE SUPPLIER SERVING THE COUNTIES 36 2. 37 OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, SCHOHARIE, AND LAWRENCE SHALL ACT AS COLLECTION AGENT FOR THE COUNTY AND SHALL 38 ST. 39 REMIT THE FUNDS COLLECTED PURSUANT TO A SURCHARGE IMPOSED UNDER THE 40 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION TO THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, SCHOHARIE, AND ST. NO WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE SUPPLIER SHALL HAVE A LEGAL 1 6. 2 OBLIGATION TO ENFORCE THE COLLECTION OF ANY SURCHARGE IMPOSED UNDER THE 3 THIS SECTION, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, THAT WHENEVER THE WIRE-PROVISIONS OF 4 LESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE SUPPLIER REMITS THE FUNDS COLLECTED TO THE 5 COUNTIES OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, SCHO-6 HARIE, AND ST. LAWRENCE, IT SHALL ALSO PROVIDE THE COUNTIES OF HAMILTON, 7 JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, SCHOHARIE, AND ST. LAWRENCE 8 THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF ANY CUSTOMER REFUSING OR FAILING TO PAY A WITH SURCHARGE IMPOSED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL STATE 9 10 THE AMOUNT OF SUCH SURCHARGE REMAINING UNPAID.

11 WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE 7. EACH SUPPLIER SHALL ANNUALLY 12 PROVIDE TO THE COUNTIES OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, 13 SCHOHARIE, AND ST. LAWRENCE AN ACCOUNTING OF THE SURCHARGE 14 AMOUNTS BILLED AND COLLECTED. ALL SURCHARGE MONIES REMITTED ΤO THE COUNTIES OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEIDA, OSWEGO, SCHO-15 16 HARIE, AND ST. LAWRENCE BY A WIRELESS COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE SUPPLIER SHALL BE EXPENDED ONLY UPON AUTHORIZATION OF THE LOCAL COUNTY LEGISLA-17 TIVE BODY AND ONLY FOR PAYMENT OF ELIGIBLE WIRELESS 911 SERVICE COSTS AS 18 19 DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION SIXTEEN OF SECTION THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE OF THIS CHAPTER. THE COUNTIES OF HAMILTON, JEFFERSON, LEWIS, NIAGARA, ONEI-20 21 DA, OSWEGO, SCHOHARIE, AND ST. LAWRENCE SHALL SEPARATELY ACCOUNT FOR AND 22 ADEQUATE BOOKS AND RECORDS OF THE AMOUNT AND SOURCE OF ALL SUCH KEEP MONIES AND OF THE AMOUNT AND OBJECT OR PURPOSE OF ALL EXPENDITURES THER-23 EOF. IF, AT THE END OF ANY FISCAL YEAR, THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF 24 ALL SUCH 25 THE AMOUNT NECESSARY FOR PAYMENT OF THE ABOVE MENTIONED MONIES EXCEEDS COSTS IN SUCH FISCAL YEAR, SUCH EXCESS SHALL BE RESERVED 26 AND CARRIED OVER FOR THE PAYMENT OF THOSE COSTS IN THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR. 27

S 5. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 and paragraph (c) of subdivision 6 of section 186-f of the tax law, paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 as added by section 3 of part B of chapter 56 of the laws of 2009 and paragraph (c) of subdivision 6 as amended by section 38 of part B of chapter 56 of the laws of 2010, are amended to read as follows:

(a) A surcharge on wireless communications service provided to a wire-33 less communications customer with a place of primary use in this state 34 35 imposed at the rate of one dollar [and twenty cents] per month on is each wireless communications device in service during any part 36 of each 37 month. The surcharge must be reflected and made payable on bills 38 rendered to the wireless communications customer for wireless communi-39 cation service.

40 Up to the sum of [seventy-five] ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN million (C) dollars annually may be used for the provision of grants or reimburse-41 ments to counties for the development, consolidation, or operation of 42 43 public safety communications systems or networks designed to support 44 statewide interoperable communications for first responders, to be 45 distributed pursuant to standards and guidelines issued by the state. Annual grants may consider costs borne by a municipality related to the 46 47 issuance of local public safety communications bonds pursuant to section 48 twenty-four hundred thirty-two of the public authorities law, when the municipality has qualified as an approved participant in a statewide interoperable communications system under the standards and guidelines 49 50 51 issued by the state, and maintains compliance with such standards and guidelines. The grant amount will be prescribed pursuant to an agreement 52 53 with the municipality, and may not exceed thirty percent of the annual 54 cost borne by the municipality in relation to such bonds;

55 S 6. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that:

1 a. subdivisions one, two and three of this act shall take effect on 2 the ninetieth day after it shall have become a law;

3 b. the provisions of subdivision 1 of section 308-z of the county law, 4 as added by section four of this act shall apply to bills rendered to 5 wireless communications service customers by a wireless communications service supplier on and after the expiration of the notice period 6 7 required pursuant to the provisions of such section; provided further, 8 that a wireless communications service supplier may treat the address used by such supplier for any wireless communications customer under a 9 10 service contract or agreement in effect on the effective date of the local law imposing such surcharge, as that wireless communications 11 customer's place of primary use for the remaining term of such service 12 contract or agreement, excluding any extension or renewal of such 13 service contract or agreement, for purposes of determining the taxing 14 jurisdiction with respect to taxes on wireless communications service. 15
