AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to establishing a process for the revocation of a code enforcement officer's certificate

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 376-a of the executive law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph (g) to read as follows:
- 3 (G) ESTABLISH A PROCEDURE TO REVOKE THE CERTIFICATION OF A CODE 4 ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL WHO IS FOUND, AFTER A HEARING, TO HAVE EITHER WILL-5 FULLY FALSIFIED AN INSPECTION REPORT, WILLFULLY MADE MATERIAL MISSTATE-6 MENTS OR MATERIAL OMISSIONS ON AN INSPECTION REPORT OR WILLFULLY ACCEPTED A BRIBE. SUCH REVOCATION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXCLUSIVE 8 REMEDY AND DOES NOT PREVENT CRIMINAL CHARGES FROM BEING BROUGHT IN ADDI-9 TION TO ANY ACTION TAKEN BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 10 S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
