Introduced by M. of A. MOSLEY -- read once and referred to the Committee on Education

AN ACT to amend chapter 507 of the laws of 1974, relating to providing for the apportionment of state monies to certain nonpublic schools, to reimburse them for their expenses in complying with certain state requirements for the administration of state testing and evaluation programs and for participation in state programs for the reporting of basic educational data, in relation to the state's immunization program

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 507 of the laws of 1974, as amended by  
2     chapter 903 of the laws of 1984, relating to providing for the appor-  
3     tionment of state monies to certain nonpublic schools, to reimburse them  
4     for their expenses in complying with certain state requirements for the  
5     administration of state testing and evaluation programs and for partic-  
6     ipation in state programs for the reporting of basic educational data,  
7     is amended to read as follows:  
8     S 3. Apportionment. a. The commissioner shall annually apportion to  
9     each qualifying school, for school years beginning on and after July  
10    first, nineteen hundred seventy-four, an amount equal to the actual cost  
11    incurred by each such school during the preceding school year for  
12    providing services required by law to be rendered to the state in  
13    compliance with the requirements of the state's pupil evaluation  
14    program, the basic educational data system, regents examinations, the  
15    statewide evaluation plan, the uniform procedure for pupil attendance  
16    reporting, THE STATE'S IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM AND OTHER HEALTH-RELATED  
17    REQUIREMENTS and other similar state prepared examinations and reporting  
18    procedures.  
19    b. The commissioner shall annually apportion to each qualifying school  
20    in the cities of New York, Buffalo and Rochester, for school years  
21    beginning on or after July first[, nineteen hundred eighty-four] TWO  
22    THOUSAND SIXTEEN, an amount equal to the actual cost incurred[, up to  
23    sixty cents per pupil,] by each such school during the preceding school  
24    year in meeting the recording and reporting requirements of the state  
25    school immunization program.  
26    S 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
