AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to prohibiting the altering of a student's official records, files and/or data

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subdivision 9-a of section 225 of the education 1 law, as 2 added by chapter 443 of the laws of 1980, is amended to read as follows: Knowingly and willfully make an unauthorized and false alter-3 9-a. ation or representation of any [grade, credit, honor, award or 4 standing in the permanent record or transcript of any student] OFFICIAL RECORDS, 5 6 FILES, AND/OR DATA RELATED TO A STUDENT AND MAINTAINED BY A SCHOOL OR 7 COLLEGE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE REGENTS, THE COMMISSIONER, OR THE 8 UNIVERSITY OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TΟ 9 ENCOMPASSING ANY OF THE MATERIAL KEPT IN THE STUDENT'S RECORD RECORDS 10 SUCH AS IDENTIFYING DATA, GRADES, ATHLETIC RECORDS, RECORDS OF ATTEND-11 AND OF ACADEMIC WORK COMPLETED, RECORDS OF STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT AND ANCE 12 ASSESSMENT RESULTS, DISCIPLINARY RECORDS, INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS, OR ANY INFORMATION INCLUDED AS PART OF A STUDENT'S EDUCATIONAL 13 14 RECORD AS DEFINED IN SECTION 99.3 OF TITLE THIRTY-FOUR OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS THE FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS 15 IMPLEMENTING AND 16 PRIVACY ACT, SECTION TWELVE HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO-G OF TITLE TWENTY OF THE UNITED STATES CODE, AS SUCH FEDERAL LAW AND REGULATIONS ARE FROM TIME TO 17 TIME AMENDED, with respect to a school or college under the supervision 18 19 of the regents, the commissioner, or the university of the state of New 20 York.

21 S 2. This act shall take effect on the first of July next succeeding 22 the date on which it shall have become a law.
