AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to enacting "Jacobe's law"

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Jacobe's law."

 S 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 15-a to read
 as follows:
- S 15-A. REPORTING BY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS. 1. SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS,
 S AS DEFINED BY SUBDIVISION SIX OF SECTION ELEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE OF
 THE EDUCATION LAW, SHALL MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO CONTACT THE PARENT
 OR GUARDIAN OF A STUDENT IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING A REPORT OF BULLYING OR
 HARASSMENT OR A REASONABLE CAUSE TO SUSPECT AN INCIDENT OF BULLYING OR
 HARASSMENT OF THE STUDENT AS DEFINED IN THIS ARTICLE.
- 10 2. THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR SHALL CONTACT THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN BY 11 TELEPHONE, ELECTRONIC MAIL, REGULAR MAIL OR OTHER MEANS.
- 12 S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
