AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to authorizing the commissioner of the office for people with developmental disabilities to have access to certain criminal history information

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 13.09 of the mental hygiene law is amended by adding a new subdivision (h) to read as follows:

2 (H) THE COMMISSIONER SHALL BE AUTHORIZED TO HAVE ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION, AS DEFINED IN PARAGRAPH (C) OF SUBDIVISION ONE OF SECTION EIGHT HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE-B OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW, CONTAINED IN CENTRAL DATA FACILITY ESTABLISHED BY THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL 6 7 JUSTICE SERVICES, UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE COMMISSIONER AND THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES SHALL 9 AGREE. THE REPORT CONTAINING SUCH CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION MAY BE SUMMARIZED FOR INCLUSION IN THE INDIVIDUAL'S CLINICAL RECORD, HOWEVER, 10 11 SUCH REPORT SHALL BE DESTROYED WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS OF ITS RECEIPT. SUCH SHALL BE USED FOR PURPOSES OF MAKING DECISIONS REGARDING 12 CARE AND TREATMENT, HEALTH AND SAFETY, PRIVILEGES AND DISCHARGE PLANNING 13 FOR INDIVIDUALS ADMITTED TO OR RETAINED IN A SCHOOL, AS DEFINED IN 14 SECTION 15.03 OF THIS TITLE, OPERATED BY THE OFFICE. THE COMMISSIONER 15 16 SHALL PROMULGATE STANDARDS REGARDING THE USE OF SUCH INFORMATION, WHICH MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO, CONSIDERATION OF THE TYPE OF OFFENSE AND THE DATE OF CONVICTION, AND ITS RELEVANCE, IF ANY, TO CARE AND 17 18 19 TREATMENT, HEALTH AND SAFETY AND DISCHARGE PLANNING. INDIVIDUALS GIVEN WRITTEN NOTICE THAT THEIR CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION WILL BE 20 OBTAINED BY THE SCHOOL, THAT THE OPPORTUNITY EXISTS 21 TO REQUEST 22 CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION AND SEEK THE CORRECTION OF ANY INACCURATE 23 CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REGULATIONS OF 24 DIVISION OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES, AND THAT THE OPPORTUNITY EXISTS
