AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to directing the council on children and families to establish an online listing and map of publicly funded or registered afterschool and school age child-care programs and to expand the duties of the commissioner of social services; and to amend the education law, in relation to expanding the duties of the commissioner of education

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1     Section 1. The social services law is amended by adding a new section  
2     483-g to read as follows:  
3     S 483-G. LIST OF CHILD CARE PROVIDERS. 1. THE COUNCIL, IN ACCORDANCE  
4     WITH INFORMATION MADE AVAILABLE TO IT BY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND  
5     FAMILY SERVICES PURSUANT TO SECTION SEVENTEEN OF THIS CHAPTER AND  
6     PROVIDED TO IT BY THE STATE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SECTION  
7     THREE HUNDRED FIVE OF THE EDUCATION LAW, SHALL DEVELOP AND MAKE AVAIL-  
8     ABLE THROUGH A LINK ON ITS WEBSITE:  
9     (A) A LISTING OF:  
10    (1) ALL RECIPIENTS OF COMPETITIVE GRANTS AWARDED OR ADMINISTERED BY  
11    THE STATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING: (I) AFTERSCHOOL OR SUMMER  
12    PROGRAMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO OF THIS CHAPTER, OR EXTENDED LEARNING  
13    TIME, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS FOR SUCH PURPOSES AWARDED  
14    UNDER SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE OF THE EDUCATION LAW; OR (II)  
15    COMMUNITY SCHOOLS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS FOR SUCH PURPOSES

3 (2) ALL REGISTERED SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE PROVIDERS REGISTERED BY THE  
4 OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES; AND

5 (B) A MAP DISPLAYING THE LOCATIONS OF THE AWARD RECIPIENTS AND PROVID-  
6 ERS DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH ONE OF PARAGRAPH (A) OF THIS SUBDIVISION.

7 2. THE LISTING SHALL INCLUDE FOR EACH GRANT RECIPIENT OR PROVIDER THE  
8 RECIPIENT'S OR PROVIDER'S NAME, THE ADDRESS AT WHICH THE PROGRAM IS  
9 OFFERED, AND THE NAME AND PHONE NUMBER OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AUTHOR-  
10 IZED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING THE PROGRAM.

11 3. THE LISTING AND MAP DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISION ONE OF THIS SECTION  
12 SHALL BE UPDATED NO LESS THAN ONCE A YEAR. THE LISTING AND MAP SHALL  
13 ALSO BE UPDATED WITHIN NINETY DAYS OF THE DATE OF EXECUTION OR EXPIRA-  
14 TION OF CONTRACTS WITH GRANT RECIPIENTS WHEN ALL SUCH CONTRACTS ARE  
15 EXECUTING OR EXPIRING FOR A PARTICULAR COMPETITIVE GRANT.

16 4. THE COUNCIL MAY INCLUDE LOCATIONS AND INFORMATION FOR ADDITIONAL  
17 RELEVANT PROGRAMS AS IT SEES FIT.

18 S 2. Subdivisions (h) and (i) of section 17 of the social services  
19 law, subdivision (h) as added and subdivision (i) as relettered by  
20 section 1 of part K-3 of chapter 57 of the laws of 2007, and subdivision  
21 (i) as amended by chapter 110 of the laws of 1971, are amended to read  
22 as follows:

23 (h) make available on its website all award allocations for request  
24 for proposals issued by the office of children and family services upon  
25 release of such awards. Such information shall also include all organ-  
26 izations requesting funding and the amounts requested for each request  
27 for proposal. The office of children and family services may also  
28 include any other information related to each program that it deems  
29 appropriate[.];

30 (i) MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE COUNCIL ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES, THROUGH  
31 THE OPENNY WEBSITE, INFORMATION REGARDING: (1) ALL RECIPIENTS OF GRANTS  
32 AWARDED OR ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE FOR THE PURPOSES OF PROVIDING  
33 AFTERSCHOOL OR SUMMER PROGRAMS AS DEFINED IN SECTION TWO OF THIS CHAP-  
34 TER, EXTENDED LEARNING TIME, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS FOR  
35 SUCH PURPOSES AWARDED UNDER SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE OF THE  
36 EDUCATION LAW, OR COMMUNITY SCHOOLS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS  
37 FOR SUCH PURPOSES AWARDED UNDER SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE OF  
38 THE EDUCATION LAW; AND (2) REGISTERED SCHOOL AGE CHILD CARE PROVIDERS  
39 REGISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES. FOR EACH GRANT  
40 RECIPIENT OR PROVIDER THE RECIPIENT'S OR PROVIDER'S NAME, THE ADDRESS AT  
41 WHICH THE PROGRAM IS OFFERED, AND THE NAME AND PHONE NUMBER OF AN INDI-  
42 VIDUAL WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING THE PROGRAM WILL  
43 BE MADE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OPENNY WEBSITE NO LESS THAN ONCE A YEAR  
44 AND WITHIN NINETY DAYS OF THE DATE OF EXECUTION OR EXPIRATION OF  
45 CONTRACTS WITH GRANT RECIPIENTS WHEN ALL SUCH CONTRACTS ARE EXECUTING OR  
46 EXPIRING FOR A PARTICULAR COMPETITIVE GRANT; AND

47 (J) exercise such other powers and perform such other duties as may be  
48 imposed by law.

49 S 3. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new  
50 subdivision 56 to read as follows:

51 56. THE COMMISSIONER SHALL PROVIDE TO THE COUNCIL ON CHILDREN AND  
52 FAMILIES, IN A FORMAT IDENTIFIED BY THE COUNCIL, INFORMATION REGARDING  
53 ALL RECIPIENTS OF GRANTS AWARDED OR ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE FOR THE  
54 PURPOSES OF PROVIDING AFTERSCHOOL OR SUMMER PROGRAMS AS DEFINED IN  
55 SECTION TWO OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES LAW, EXTENDED LEARNING TIME, INCLUD-  
56 ING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS FOR SUCH PURPOSES AWARDED UNDER SECTION

1 THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE OF THIS CHAPTER, OR COMMUNITY SCHOOLS,  
2 INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO GRANTS FOR SUCH PURPOSES AWARDED UNDER  
3 SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED FORTY-ONE OF THIS CHAPTER. FOR EACH GRANT  
4 RECIPIENT OR PROVIDER THE RECIPIENT'S OR PROVIDER'S NAME, THE ADDRESS AT  
5 WHICH THE PROGRAM IS OFFERED, AND THE NAME AND PHONE NUMBER OF AN INDI-  
6 VIDUAL WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO ANSWER QUESTIONS REGARDING THE PROGRAM WILL  
7 BE PROVIDED TO THE COUNCIL NO LESS THAN ONCE A YEAR AND WITHIN NINETY  
8 DAYS OF THE DATE OF EXECUTION OR EXPIRATION OF CONTRACTS WITH GRANT  
9 RECIPIENTS WHEN ALL SUCH CONTRACTS ARE EXECUTING OR EXPIRING FOR A  
10 PARTICULAR COMPETITIVE GRANT.

11 S 4. Section 2 of the social services law is amended by adding two new  
12 subdivisions 39 and 40 to read as follows:

13 39. "AFTERSCHOOL PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN A PROGRAM CONDUCTED OUTSIDE THE  
14 REGULAR SCHOOL DAY WHEREBY STUDENTS CAN PARTICIPATE IN ENRICHMENT ACTIV-  
15 ITIES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ATHLETICS, ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT, ART,  
16 MUSIC, DRAMA, ACADEMIC TUTORING, MENTORING, COMMUNITY SERVICES AND  
17 RELATED PROGRAMS THAT WILL PROMOTE POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, PHYSICAL  
18 AND/OR EMOTIONAL WELLNESS, EDUCATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT, AND/OR SCHOOL,  
19 CIVIC, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT.

20 40. "SUMMER PROGRAM" SHALL MEAN A PROGRAM CONDUCTED OUTSIDE THE REGU-  
21 LAR SCHOOL YEAR WHEREBY STUDENTS CAN PARTICIPATE IN ENRICHMENT ACTIV-  
22 ITIES INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ATHLETICS, ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT, ART,  
23 MUSIC, DRAMA, ACADEMIC TUTORING, MENTORING, COMMUNITY SERVICES AND  
24 RELATED PROGRAMS THAT WILL PROMOTE POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT, PHYSICAL  
25 AND/OR EMOTIONAL WELLNESS, EDUCATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT, AND/OR SCHOOL,  
26 CIVIC, FAMILY AND COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT, AND SHALL NOT INCLUDE REQUIRED  
27 SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAMMING PURSUANT TO SECTION THIRTY-SIX HUNDRED TWO OF  
28 THE EDUCATION LAW.

29 S 5. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall  
30 have become a law.
