AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to the personal income tax credit for certain household and dependent care services necessary for gainful employment

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subsection (c) of section 606 of the tax law, as amended by section 1 of part M of chapter 63 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:

(1) A taxpayer shall be allowed a credit as provided herein equal to applicable percentage of the credit allowable under section twentyone of the internal revenue code for the same taxable year (without regard to whether the taxpayer in fact claimed the credit under such section twenty-one for such taxable year). The applicable percentage shall be the sum of (i) twenty percent and (ii) a multiplier multiplied by a fraction. For taxable years beginning in nineteen hundred ninetysix and nineteen hundred ninety-seven, the numerator of such fraction shall be the lesser of (i) four thousand dollars or (ii) fourteen thousand dollars less the New York adjusted gross income for the taxable year, provided, however, the numerator shall not be less than zero. For the taxable year beginning in nineteen hundred ninety-eight, the numerasuch fraction shall be the lesser of (i) thirteen thousand dollars or (ii) thirty thousand dollars less the New York adjusted gross income for the taxable year, provided, however, the numerator shall not be less than zero. For taxable years beginning in nineteen hundred ninety-nine, the numerator of such fraction shall be the lesser of (i) fifteen thousand dollars or (ii) fifty thousand dollars less

York adjusted gross income for the taxable year, provided, however, the numerator shall not be less than zero. For taxable years beginning after 3 nineteen hundred ninety-nine, the numerator of such fraction shall lesser of (i) fifteen thousand dollars or (ii) sixty-five thousand 5 dollars less the New York adjusted gross income for the taxable year, 6 however, the numerator shall not be less than zero. provided, 7 denominator of such fraction shall be four thousand dollars for taxable years beginning in nineteen hundred ninety-six and nineteen hundred 8 ninety-seven, thirteen thousand dollars for the taxable year beginning 9 10 in nineteen hundred ninety-eight, and fifteen thousand dollars for taxa-11 ble years beginning after nineteen hundred ninety-eight. S 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2016.
