Introduced by M. of A. CROUCH -- read once and referred to the Committee on Governmental Employees -- committee discharged, bill amended, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee -- again reported from said committee with amendments, ordered reprinted as amended and recommitted to said committee

AN ACT to grant Cole Samsel eligibility for permanent appointment as a police officer with the police department of the village of Oxford, in the county of Chenango

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1     Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of paragraph (a) of subdivi-  
2     sion 1 or subdivision 4 of section 58 of the civil service law to the  
3     contrary, Cole Samsel, who previously received a permanent appointment  
4     in the competitive class of civil service as a police officer with the  
5     sheriff's department of the county of Chenango, resigned from such posi-  
6     tion after several years, has been absent from such position for more  
7     than 30 days and is over the age of 35, shall be eligible to take the  
8     competitive civil service examination for the position of police officer  
9     and shall, contingent upon his score on such examination, be eligible to  
10    be placed on the eligible list for appointment as a full-time patrolman  
11    for the village of Oxford.  
12    S 2. Cole Samsel shall otherwise be subject to the merit and fitness  
13    provisions of the civil service law applicable to full-time police offi-  
14    cers.  
15    S 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
